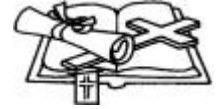

Liturgical Question Box

Q. What is a "Commemoration"?

A. Some saints have a higher place on the Church calendar. For instance, St. Joseph, who is the Patron of the Universal Church, has a First Class Feast (actually two separate ones). The lowest rank of a saint's feast is a 4th Class "Commemoration." That means that the saint is remembered at the Mass and at Lauds (the morning prayer of the Church) with a prayer but the priest does not have to say the Mass of that saint – although he is free to do so. Another type of Commemoration is made for very important days of the Church year. For example, every day of Lent is a "Privileged Commemoration" which means that, no matter what Mass is said (even on a First Class Feast) the prayer for Lent is added.
