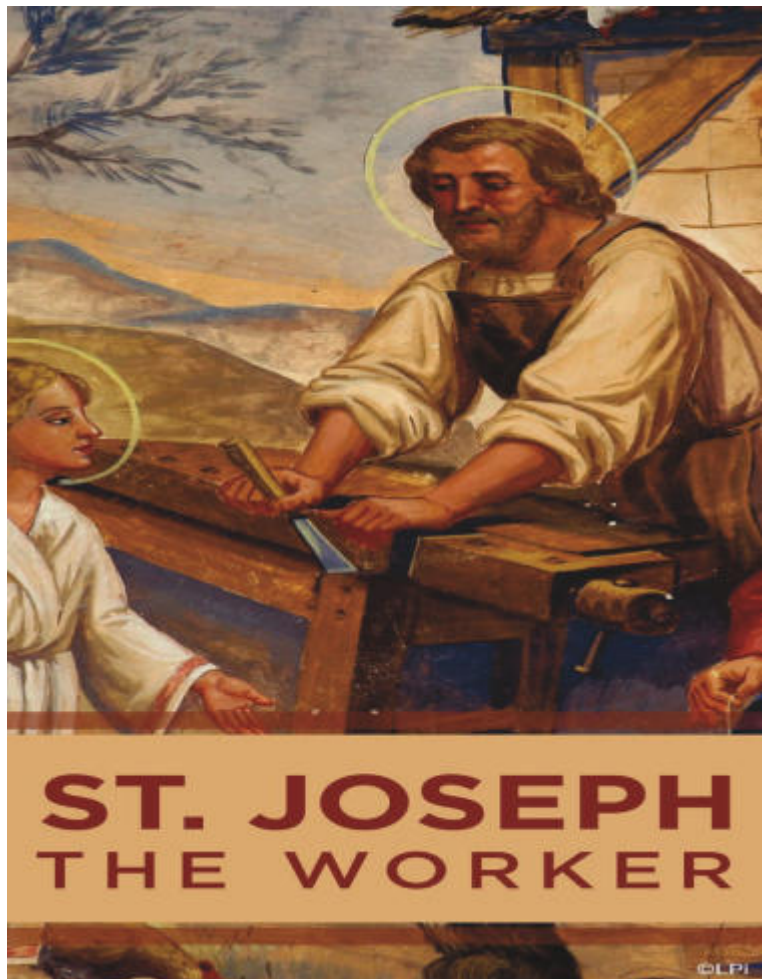

Liturgical Question Box

Q. On the weekly Mass calendar, what do these mean next to each day: (I Cl., II Cl., III Cl., IV Cl.)?

A. Each day of the year is dedicated to honoring God in one of His various Mysteries (such as Trinity Sunday, Corpus Christi or Christmas) or through one of His saints. On the Traditional calendar, each Feast or day has a particular rank: 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th Class (or, abbreviated: I Cl., II Cl., III Cl., IV Cl.). This helps us to know which Feasts are given more emphasis. First Class Feasts are the greatest in the Church year, such as Christmas, the Immaculate Conception, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, etc. Second Class Feasts are lesser feasts but still celebrate a major Mystery or Saint, such as the feasts of the Apostles or a major saint such as St. Anne. The Third Class Feasts are mostly those of the saints. Fourth Class Days are days which do not have a particular saint assigned. On these days, normally, the priest can use the Mass of the preceding Sunday or he can say a Votive Mass of a particular saint or Mystery of his choosing. On 4th Class days at ICC, we try to announce which Mass will be used at the beginning of Mass, to help those attending properly set their hand missals to follow the readings and prayers of that day’s Mass.
