### **Baptisms & Marriages**



### January 1 Octave of Christmas

According to the norms published by the USCCB, January 1, 2022 is not a Holy Day of Obligation this year. Whenever this feast falls on a Saturday, as it does this year, "the obligation is abrogated". To close the secular year at ICC we will have Adoration on December 31 beginning at 11:00 pm. At 11:45 we will sing the Te Deum (plenary indulgence on that day) in thanksgiving for the graces of the year. This will be followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament and Low Mass at 12:15 am. On Saturday, January 1, we will have 8:00 am Low Mass and 10:00 am Sung Mass.


