Epiphany in the Home

Whether or not you have a priest visit your home for an individual blessing, you should take a piece of chalk blessed on Epiphany and have the head of the household write the following inscription above your front door inside:

20 + C + M + B + 22

This represents the year (2022) and the initials of the three Kings, Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar. Epiphany water should be sprinkled in all rooms of the house by the head of the household as well.

Announcement of Easter

Traditionally, on Epiphany Day in Cathedral and other principal Churches, after the Gospel was sung, the approaching Feast of Easter Sunday was solemnly announced to the people. The custom dates from the earliest ages of the Church and shows the mysterious connection which unites the great Feasts of the Church year with one another. The form of the announcement is as follows:

Know, dearly beloved Brethren, that by the mercy of God, as we have been rejoicing in the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, so also do we announce unto you the joy of the Resurrection of the same Our Savior. Septuagesima Sunday will be on the 13th day of February. Ash Wednesday and the beginning of the fast of the most Holy Lent will be on the 2nd of March. On the 17th of April, we shall celebrate with joy the Holy Pasch of Our Lord Jesus Christ. The Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ will be on the 26th of May. The Feast of Pentecost on the 5th of June. The Feast of Corpus Christi on the 16th of June. On the 27th of November will occur the first Sunday of the Advent of Our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom are honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Blessing of Epiphany Water

This Wednesday, January 5, the Vigil of the Epiphany, following the 6 pm Mass we will have the solemn blessing of Epiphany Water. This sung ceremony will take about 45 minutes. You may bring water to be blessed at any time prior to the Mass that evening. All containers of water should be placed in the back area under the bulletin board . Every container must be at least one gallon in size and each family may bring a maximum of 3 containers. Smaller containers can be filled after the ceremony from the dispenser in the church.

Feast of the Epiphany

On January 6 we will have Solemn Mass at 6:00 pm for the Feast of the Epiphany.

Epiphany Blessings

In the back of the church there is a schedule of all the houses to be blessed during the Octave of the Epiphany. We have tried to accommodate the request of each house to the best that we can. The times are estimations based upon travel times, so we may be running a bit ahead or (more likely!) a bit behind. If you have provided you a phone number, we will call with a more precise ETA.

First Friday Schedule January 7 is the First Friday. We will, therefore, have a 7:00 pm Solemn Mass (rather than the usual 6:00 pm Mass) followed by Adoration

of the Blessed Sacrament and the Act or Reparation to the Sacred Heart. The two youth catechism classes and the Youth Group will not meet this Friday. They will resume January 14.

January 8 Knights of the Altar

The Knights of the Altar will meet this month on Saturday, January 8. It will follow the usual schedule following the 9 am Mass and conclude at 1 pm.

Sodality of the Blessed Virgin Mary

The Sodality of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a group for young ladies in a parish who seek to be formed intellectually and in the virtues by taking Our Lady as their model.
