~ Adoration – High Form of Prayer ~

On Trinity Sunday we celebrate God for all He is in all His majesty and wonder, above all that He desires us and to be always with us. God, in His goodness and love, has promised to, “be with [us] always even to the end of the age.” (Mt 28:20) God fulfills this promise by giving us the Eucharist. A powerful way of remaining with God is to spend time in Eucharistic Adoration. Adoration is allowing ourselves to be present to God. Being in God’s presence brings refreshment to our souls. He calms the heat of our anger, restores our energy, brings us peace and joy. “A peace beyond all human understanding.” (Phil 4:7) God gives us many things that we cannot find in this world.

Eucharistic adoration can take place wherever the Blessed sacrament is. What most people think of as Eucharistic Adoration is Solemn Eucharistic Adoration when the Blessed Sacrament is out of the tabernacle in a monstrance for all to see. (Monstrare is the Latin word for to show). All of us should adore God, it is what is due to God, whether in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament or not. Adoration is a high form of prayer by which we acknowledge God as God, Creator, Author, Savior, and Lord of all that exists.

Those who see the good fruit of Eucharistic adoration, love it. Some have said they can begin to desire adoration more than the Mass. Yet the Mass is the highest form of prayer. Here is how I would compare the two. Mass is a very intentional, structured form of prayer given to us by God. We worship God, thanking Him for everything He has done for us that week. We know the structure, the sign of the cross, the penitential rite, reading scripture, the Homily, and the Eucharistic prayers. At the Mass we know what to expect. Adoration is different, we have the freedom to just be with God. To adore Him. To enjoy free time with God. There is minimal structure. For this reason, some people love adoration. God moves them, speaks directly to them. But for others the lack of structure makes them uneasy, so they add structure to adoration.

In Eucharistic adoration it is enough to remain with Jesus, to be content to be in His presence as He is content to be with you. There is no need to feel that one must force their prayer. To adore Jesus in the Eucharist, is to demonstrate that our hope is in Jesus. That we count on Him to show us the way and guide us through life. To adore Jesus is to give God the freedom to move in your heart to help you see and understand how God sees you and the world. There is no need to fill the time with thoughts and words, as if it all depended upon us. As we spend more and more time in adoration, we learn how God speaks in the silence of our souls, and how the Holy Spirit gives us words to speak back to God. The beauty of adoration is that it is our time to be hidden with God, to know at a deeper level the one we will spend all of eternity with.
