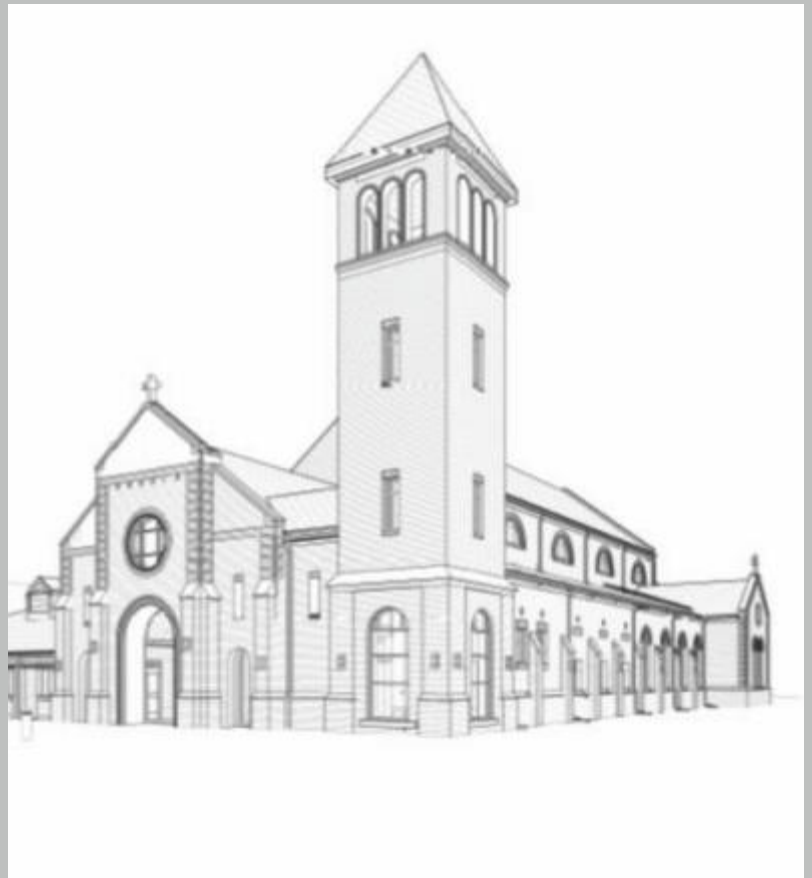

## History Glimpse

St. Patrick parish is one of the oldest parishes in Lincoln, and naturally has a history that contains some pretty dramatic stories since it has existed during some very dramatic times. This History Glimpse and others that follow will visit some of those interesting stories. They can present some very vivid scenes. For example, think of how proud the parishioners must have been to have their new church (something we can identify with today). There are probably a number of parishioners today who have no

memory of that church building, but the parishioners of 1912 thought it was beautiful. Jackie Hart, who has been a member of this parish her entire life, tells how her grandparents had built a barn on their farm property north of Lincoln, and held a benefit barn dance and oyster stew supper in it to raise money for the new church. They served the food from the horse stalls and ate in the haymow. Then they danced to a fiddler and a banjo player's music. It's easy to imagine the fun they all must have had. It would be fun today, wouldn't it? They raised \$100 for the church...a lot of money in those days.
