#### LETTER FROM OUR PRIESTS

Dear friends,

The new year is always a good chance for us to take stock of what changes we would like to make in our lives. One of the keys to making our resolutions stick is to make them very practical and concrete, so to that end I want to offer a couple of concrete ways God may be calling you to love your neighbor and our parishes this year.

First, Fr. Conway and I are planning on trying to visit all of our homebound parishioners this year, but due to COVID we are aware that our records are out of date, so we need your help. Do you have a family member or friend who you know to be homebound who would want or need a visit from one of the priests? Please ask their permission first, and then share their contact information with our staff.

Secondly, we need help at Masses! In both parishes, we are finding that oftentimes the same generous people are stepping up for serving as sacristan, altar serving, lectoring, singing, etc. While we applaud that generosity, a parish that is alive should be able to have enough ministers for each Mass who show up (or get replacements) for their scheduled time, and enough ministers that we can share the labor week to week.

Archbishop has often said that one of the marks of a thriving parish is "vital worship." If we wish to show that our parishes are alive, we need to be willing to offer ourselves for liturgical service, even if it isn't always at our preferred Mass time. We are blessed with many scheduled Mass times at our parishes, but we need many ministers to assist at those Masses to make them beautiful offerings to our Lord.


