### **LETTER FROM OUR PRIESTS**

#### Brothers and Sisters,

Our second reading this weekend from St. Paul reminds us of a very important fact that is essential for a healthy parish. "There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone." It can be so easy to look at someone else and be jealous of their gifts, asking ourselves why we can't be like them. But God has given each of us the gifts we need, and as a community, we need all the gifts of each individual member.

I love that our parishes are so diverse in our forms of worship and gifts. While we may find ourselves more at home in a particular Mass, we can never forget our point of unity. All of us come here for the worship of the one God. All of our gifts are given by the same Lord. What unites us is so much greater than the differences. These differences are important and should be celebrated! They add to the richness of the faith that each of us experiences. I love that our parishes truly show a little bit of the universal Church in our differences in rites and languages. We have students in public schools, home schools, and Catholic schools. And yet, we come together as a community to worship the one God in whose image and likeness we have been made. This is worth celebrating!

We also need to remember that our gifts are given not just for us, but to be put at the disposal of the entire community. We are able to offer so much at these parishes only because we have volunteers who offer their gifts in service to our community. We would like to do more as well, to expand our adult faith formation offerings, grow our religious education program, increase our outreach to the poor, and to reach out to the community to spread the Gospel. We cannot do that without the gifts that each of us has to offer. As we reflect on St. Paul's letter to the Corinthians, please take some time to think about how you can use the gifts God has given you to give back to him through your parish. When we do that, then we can worship God truly with all that we are as a community of faith.
