

Epiphany -Lễ Ba Vua

In the secular world by now the Christmas music has stopped playing, Christmas decorations are put away, the Christmas tree is probably on the street, and people are probably back to the normal routine of daily life. But the Church continues to celebrate God's love for humanity through today: the Feast of "Epiphany"; feast of three Kings, the Magi, God's manifestation of Christ as the Son of God.

The Feast of Epiphany is a very early feast of the Church. The Church set both Christmas day and Epiphany as feast days on Dec. 25 and Jan. 6 respectively, and named the twelve days between the two feasts as the Christmas Season.

There are many practices in the world around the Feast of Epiphany. In Italy people bring sweets to give to children. In Latin America, the Philippines, and Spain, people exchange gifts for this feast. In my own country, Vietnam, it is customary to bless our own home with Holy Water and light a candle to dispel the darkness of evil. At my family's home, I remember the night before the feast we would deep clean the house to imitate the difficult journey of the Magi to find the Messiah. The day of Epiphany we would gather behind my mother at the entrance of the house, bless it, say a prayer, and bless the door with Holy Water. We would repeat the blessing in every room of the house. Those rituals are still carried on within my family today.

At St. Benedict/Sacred Heart we priests invite all of our families to attend Mass, and on the way out please take a piece of blessed chalk, (many colors of chalk are available) and the instruction sheet on how to bless your own home:

20XX for the year—The 3 Magi: C-Casper, M-Melchior, B-Balthasar

"Christus Mansionem Benedicat" (May Christ Bless this House in Latin)

May all of us here at St. Benedict/Sacred Heart on this feast day, when the Magi find the Lord, invite the Lord to transform our lives, and may we continue to bring the Good News of Christ's birth into the world.

Religious Education News




