

♦♦♦ PRIEST'S MESSAGE ♦♦♦

Hiring. For several months now, we have had an opening in our finance department (for the parishes). We have been blessed with all manner of volunteers helping us fill the gaps—but none of them is a permanent solution. We very much need to hire a staff member to fill this position. What is the position? We could go either of two ways: a bookkeeper or an accountant/business-manager. Ultimately, we would like to be able to bring someone on board that could manage our finances for all the Catholic entities (SH, SB, School, and Foundation). This higher level position would take some pressure off of the priests and staff members here. However, if there is no one like this available, we would be happy to hire a bookkeeper who could help us process all the gifts and donations that come our way. Both are full-time positions. Please invite qualified candidates to talk to me, Father Tom.

In addition to this, we are also keeping our eyes open for the following positions: Music Director, Facility Manager, Religious Education Aide, Marketing/Advertising Helper.

Synod. On January 30th here in Yankton we will be having a gathering to talk about the Synod of Synodality—an initiative of the Holy Father, Pope Francis. The basic purpose is to listen and gather ideas and thoughts from people all around the world. These ideas and thoughts will then be gathered together for him. I would like to ask as many of you as possible to come and learn about the synod, and provide your feedback to the survey (yet to come).

Construction updates. At St. Benedict, we have recently finished up some "stenciling" of the columns to the right and left of the sanctuary. I'm excited about the way they draw the eyes upward to heaven! We continue to proceed a little at a time—the next thing is we will be looking at how to include the Mary & Joseph statues back into the sanctuary.

It sounds like the Stations of the Cross will be arriving toward the end of January or early February. It would be wonderful to get them up before Lent. But I'm not sure how soon we will be able to accomplish it. The stained-glass windows will still be months before they will be finished.

At Sacred Heart, Phase 1 to repair the roof and the air-handler has been approved by Bishop. Work will likely be happening on this in April or May. For phase 2, which is more for aesthetics and functionality of our church, we have turned to Co-op Architecture out of Sioux Falls and Aberdeen. Sometime this spring they will be getting us drawings to look at and consider. Construction on Phase 2 will likely be 2023 or 2024.

Calling all Spiritual Entrepreneurs. The most vibrant parishes are those in which the people in the pews take responsibility for their spiritual home. With that in mind, I want to encourage you to listen to the Holy Spirit whispering in your hearts. Do you notice something that you think needs to be provided or improved at the parish? Consider leading it yourself! You can make a difference for yourself and your brothers and sisters in Christ. The gift of yourself could be just the thing to turn our parishes into amazing parishes!

(Surveys also will be available on-line starting in February).


Begin praying and listening now to the Holy Spirit for the needs you see in our local parishes, and for our local Church, this gathering of Christians!
