

God in our daily life?



Have you ever felt that your spiritual life has no flavor? Or asked yourself, Is God really a presence in my life? We are almost finished with the first month of the New Year. Just about everywhere you go, including shopping malls, grocery stores and even television commercials, you see advertisements that promote health awareness. If you eat right and exercise you will live a long and happy life.

The Church challenges the faithful to live out their baptismal promises in order to have eternal life. There are two stories in the bible that I have always admired. The first is the call of Abram (later Abraham) to leave his homeland and travel to an unknown land. He answers that call and is blessed with a great nation. The second story is the Transfiguration of Jesus before Peter, James and John who witness the event. In both encounters, the people involved allowed God to work in their lives and thus created the opportunity for God to change their lives.

So, what can you do to encounter God?

- + Prepare yourself for Sunday liturgy before coming to Mass by reading the Sunday Scripture readings.
- + Create a prayer area in your home
- + Share your experience about God with another person or persons
- + Go to confession on a regular basis
- + Reach out to a local homeless shelter, visit a homebound person, help at a food pantry...etc...

If you do all these, chances are you truly will encounter God and allow God to transform your life.



Candlemas-Feast of Presentation-Feast of the Purification of Mary, February 2nd -In the Gospel for this day, we hear how Mary and Joseph faithfully follow the Law of Moses found in Leviticus that says an infant boy, in this case Jesus, should be circumcised on the eighth day after birth, that thirty-three days later the mother is considered clean, and forty days after the birth she should bring an offering to the temple to be burned for her purification and the boy's presentation at the temple. Although we live in a different age and a different world, how faithfully do we follow the teachings of Jesus? On this Feast of the Presentation, also called Candlemas Day, the Church has a long tradition of blessing all candles which will be used throughout the year. You and your family are invited to come to Mass and bring a candle to be blessed for use in your home. We light the candle, representing Jesus as the light of the world to dispel the darkness of sins and bring the light of salvation. May you and your family come to this Mass, bring the light of Christ into your home, and let the light of Christ shine in your heart, in your home, and radiate into the world.
