

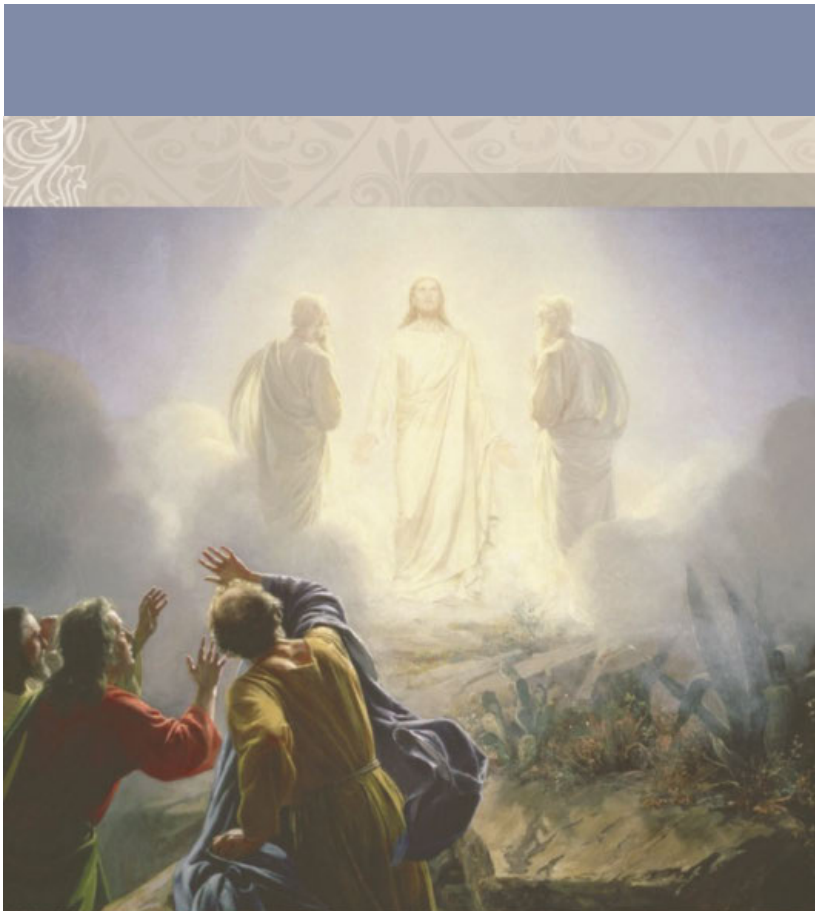

2nd Sunday of Lent

Let me back up, way up! On Ash Wednesday, I asked “what grace are you asking for during Lent?” I myself did not have an answer. Well, I do now.

I ask for the **grace** of peace for the people and government of Ukraine. When I experience any of the PFA – the prayer, fasting, and almsgiving of Lent – and I become conscious that I am joining in the PFA, I offer a prayer to Jesus for my Ukraine intention.

Here’s a tangible example: when I do my Exodus 90 asceticism of the “Cold Shower Hokey Pokey,” I ask Jesus to bless the men and women and children of Ukraine who are engaged in a fight for life and livelihood. I give the Father thanks for running water. I personally thank the staff stocking the shelves at 10:30p. I give God thanks for food on the shelves and for all the people in the *whole* supply line and the safety and security of our nation that makes all that possible.

You and I need to cultivate a deep gratitude for what we have. Too often do I encounter people who say: “It could be worse”, “At least it’s not as bad as ...”, or “not too bad.”

What a load of trash! It’s not even a load of crap – that at least will fertilize fields!!! Look at the object of the sentence – it’s a negative thing! That means the focus is on the *privation* of good, instead of what is *good!*

This Lent, when you experience some of the privations of your Lenten PFA – focus on the good in your life, give thanks to God the Father, and ask Jesus to fulfill the **grace** of your Lent!

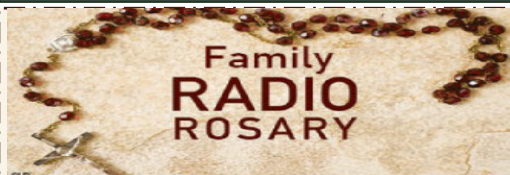

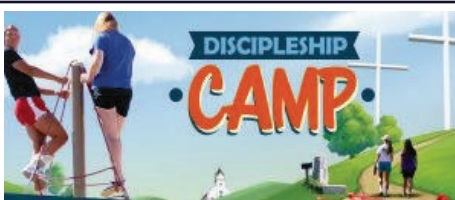

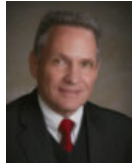
