◆◆◆ PRIEST'S MESSAGE ◆◆◆



Since Ash Wednesday I have been really happy to see an increase in Mass attendance at St. Benedict Parish and Sacred Heart Parish, particularly in the number of daily Mass goers. As a priest it is always a joy to see the congregation take seriously their spiritual growth and faith life development.

A challenge I have been hearing about is sporting events taking place on Sunday at a time which interferes with Sunday Mass. I ask parents to use your conscience. If your child is truly gifted in a sport, think about creating the opportunity to challenge the sports system not to schedule an event that conflicts with the practice of the faith that you believe in! This would be a great way for us to raise our voices in testimony of our faith.

Talking about Faith . . . Are you aware that we do have the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adult) program in our parish? For those not baptized or baptized in another faith tradition, this is a process in which the person may explore becoming a Catholic. Every Fall a group of adults gather to begin that process. This group meets regularly with lay leaders and a priest. The group moves in stages or steps toward Lent and the Easter Vigil when Baptism is celebrated. During Lent we have rituals for these steps. Last Sunday and for the next two Sundays we celebrate rituals called Scrutinies at St. Benedict parish. The Scrutinies are for unbaptized persons in which we pray that they will persevere in their journey toward receiving the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist) at the Easter Vigil. So, in your prayers please include these individuals, our Elect:

- Courtney Krienert-St. Benedict
- Amanda Steiner-St. Benedict

If you know of anyone interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith, or interested in joining the Catholic Church, please contact one of our offices for additional information.

Holy Week and Easter joy is approaching, please prepare yourself by going to confession and taking full advantage of the graces of this sacrament. Also, plan to attend and participate in all of our Holy Week services. These services are a great opportunity for us to deepen our faith: The Living Faith and We are Alive.

As a final note, having a Living Faith motivates us to act. One concrete action is to consider visiting our homebound parishioners. We are in need of volunteers to perform that wonderful ministry. Our list of homebound people continues to grow every day. So, if you are interested, please contact me!

Another concrete action would be to respond to the urging of Pope Francis to participate in a world-wide consecration of Russia and the Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on March 25th. The Yankton Catholic Community will participate by hosting a 1 hour prayer service for this purpose **this Sunday, March 27th at the House of Mary Shrine at 7pm.** Light refreshments will follow, please bring your families, our faith alive can move mountains!

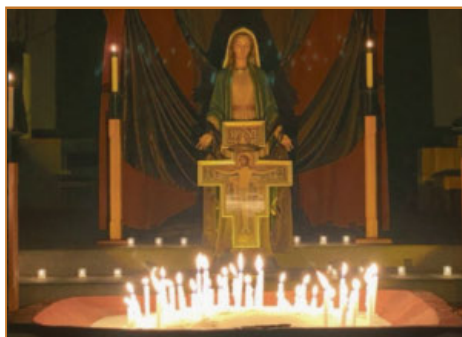
