◆◆ PRIEST’S MESSAGE ◆◆

Lent Palm Sunday



The Palm leaf is a powerful little creature. When we gathered them together, they arrived in a multitude of displays. As Lent approached, our baskets abounded with variety; some intricately woven into spirals and braids, others into various movable octagonal shapes. The most common shape, though, was the simple blade. This single and lowly blade was all the more telling of its purpose. It reminded all who passed, by its position tucked into the calendar, that Jesus had passed by that way. And we burned that palm.

We turned that humble creature, the palm, into its cousin, ashes. And we smeared them on our foreheads into the sign of our salvation – the cross our Savior, Jesus, carried for us and allowed himself to be affixed onto that creature, the tree. There the Creator of all things was affixed to his creature, wood, in a most dazzling paradox: he was enthroned on a crucifix. He turned shame into gain and death into victory.

Today as we take the strong and profound palm leaf home, may it grace our homes with the story of the passage of Christ who has woven himself into the very warp and weft of the tapestry of our lives!

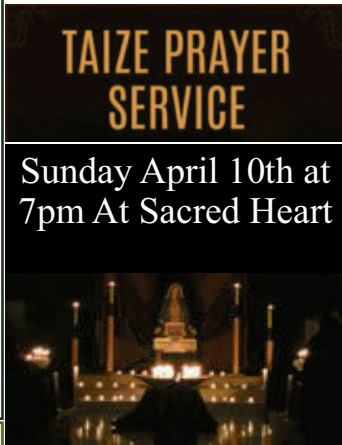
The offering that is collected on Good Friday will be for the Holy Land. The offering for Easter is for the parish.
