◆◆◆ PRIEST’S MESSAGE ◆◆◆



I admire Churchill. I think it’s amazing what he was able to accomplish for the world in the first World War. His great speeches and courageous leadership made a difference in the world. Yet he died. Similarly, I have great respect for Socrates, Plato, and Aristotle. These incredible minds saw so many things about the nature of the world and humanity.

Yet they died.

The people around Jesus asked Him: “are you greater than our fathers and the prophets who came before us? They all died. Are you greater than them?” This is the fundamental question of Christianity: are you Jesus fundamentally the same as all other people, or are you different?” The apostles of Easter joy say “yes, He is different!”

Jesus spoke like no others because He had existed before all others. He did things that no one had ever seen because He was someone that no one had ever seen. Death could not contain Him, because there is nothing but LIFE in Him.

And for those who came to believe in Him, He gave power to become children of the Living God. We are heirs of this promise. The baptized Christians (all of us) are those who have accepted that God has come to earth. We are the ones who have been brought into the huge family of the Church. If only ALL people knew what would bring them life.

Something amazing has happened. Because God has come to earth and has died for us, we can become children of God by adoption. Let’s share this amazing news and invite others to come to Jesus our Lord in the Sacraments of the Church.

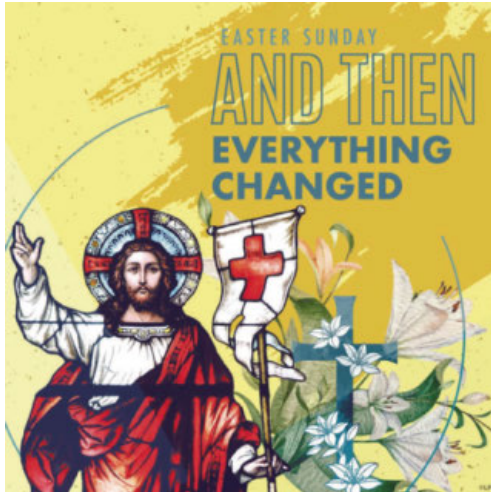
Starting this weekend we will resume the “Sign of Peace” which is shortly after the Our Father at Mass. The Sign of Peace is a beautiful part of the liturgy that we chose to forgo for a time. But now with the cold, flu, and covid seasons behind us, we will take it up again. If you are still uncomfortable shaking hands, I simply encourage you to hold your hands close to your chest during that part of the Mass. Perhaps if you want, you may nod your head to those who wish to share peace with you. We offered some special times for daily Masses during the Lenten season. At St. Benedict the Tuesday morning Mass was moved to 7am. At Sacred Heart, the Thursday Mass was moved to 11:55a. It seemed to many that these new Mass times were preferable to the previous way. Thus, we will be continuing with these new times indefinitely.

Also, we will be changing the Mass time for Friday morning at Sacred Heart to be 11:55a just like we have been doing on Thursday. Up till now we have needed two priests available to celebrate both Friday morning Masses, because the Masses happened to be celebrated at nearly the same time. This has become problematic for us priests because it is Fr. Thi's day off, and Fr. Bob often has to go away for guard drill weekends early Friday. So, we will try something different. We are hoping that the Friday 11:55a time will be well received by parishioners. This new change will allow me (Fr. Tom) to take both Masses if required.
