◆◆ PRIEST’S MESSAGE ◆◆



“...here are the beginnings of creatures newly formed: children born from the life-giving font of holy Church, born anew with the simplicity of little ones, and crying out with the evidence of a clean conscience.”

From an Easter homily by an ancient author

Looking back on the Triduum that we just celebrated last week, there are a number of things that stick with me. Perhaps the most encouraging was the look of those of our newest members at the Easter Vigil. Some wore a huge grin, others were deep in thought and contemplation of the mighty thing that was happening. They thought about what Easter meant for them. But what does this time period mean for the rest of us?

In the coming weeks at the Sunday liturgies, we will hear from the Acts of the Apostles. This book of the bible follows immediately after the Gospel of John and speaks of the Apostles and early Church right after Christ’s resurrection. Again and again we hear the apostles tell about Jesus--his life, his teachings, his suffering, death, and resurrection. But in every case they instructed the people to be Baptized. After this they called everyone together for “the breaking of the bread”--a code phrase for the Eucharist or Mass. The death and resurrection led to the Sacraments and to the Church. The apostles came together as the first bishops, the disciples formed the first parish.

Perhaps, this is what we should keep in mind as we move through this Easter season: the Church is Christ’s gift to us. The Church is His plan for us to be united to Him. The Church and our parishes are the place the Christians grow in the grace and love of Christ week-by-week, and year-by-year. We encourage one another by example of holiness and exhortations to virtue. We try to live our lives in the pattern of our Lord.

And now we welcome our newest members into this fellowship we have with one another. In addition to our “Neophytes” (or “Newbies” as I like to call them) we also welcome in a special way our first communicants who are receiving the Blessed Sacrament, the very Body and Blood of our Lord, for the first time.
