

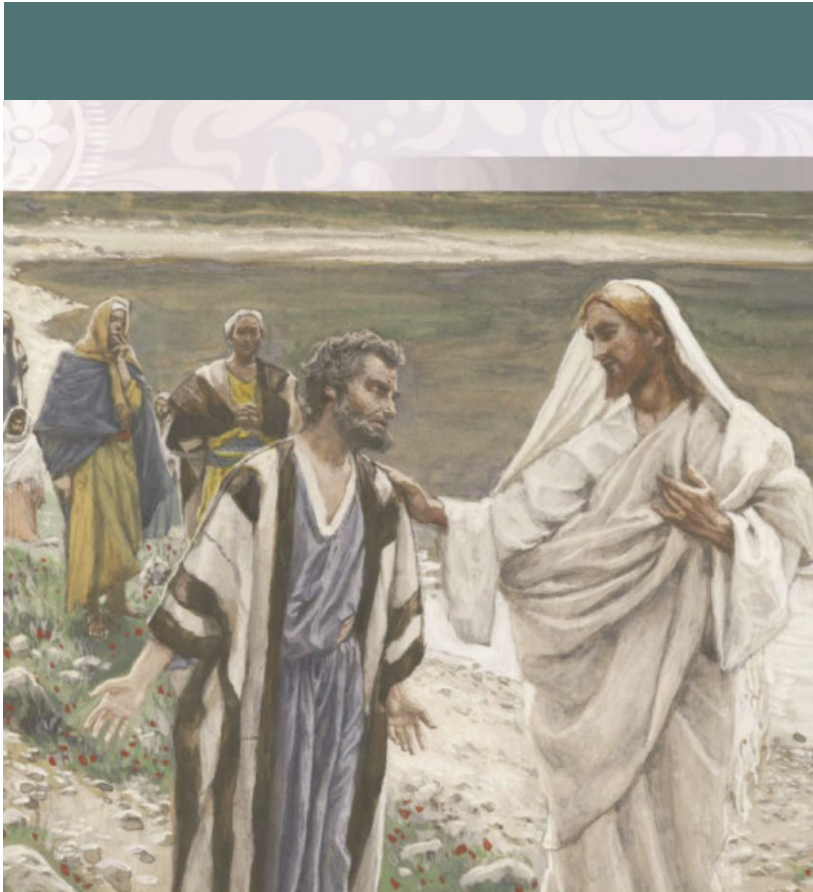

◆◆◆ PRIEST’S MESSAGE ◆◆◆

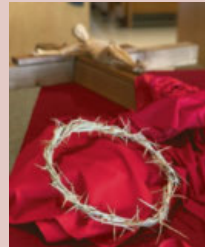
Roll Away the Stone and Be Free

WOW, what a celebration!!! 15 years as a priest means 15 celebrations of the Holy Triduum. So far my Yankton experience is at the top on my list. Let's recap the events of this sacred week.

On Palm Sunday we all gathered outside the church and began with the blessing of palms and sang, “Hosanna to the King who came to save us.” Holy Thursday we received the oil of the Catechumens, oil of the Sick, and the Sacred Chrism consecrated by Bishop DeGroot and distributed to parishes throughout the diocese with a wonderful life-giving action. We witnessed the washing of feet and heard Jesus’ invitation to wash each other's feet as well, recalling His command to serve one another.

We experienced the solemn procession of the Holy Eucharist to the Altar of Repose area, and kept Vigil with Jesus until midnight. Thanks to the Knights of Columbus who organized a group of men who assisted at this wonderful event. What a great turnout for this holy night!

Good Friday we adored the Cross of Jesus reminding ourselves to embrace our own cross and follow the Master.



Then we celebrated the holiest of nights: The Easter Vigil. As a new resident of South Dakota, I’ve experienced many wind gusts more than 50mph, but miraculously on the Easter Vigil the wind was calm!

We could have the Easter Fire! Hallelujah!

On Easter Sunday it was such a wonderful experience to see the parking lot filled, and the Church packed and having such a wonderful feeling of THE CHURCH IS ALIVE! We offer 365 Masses per year at each parish, at St. Ben we have 72 weekend Masses, and at Sacred Heart we have 96 weekend Masses. Please plan your schedule to come for spiritual nourishment. The cost is FREE!

The Easter celebration of joy continues for a total of 50 days from Easter Sunday until Pentecost. During this time, we will hear from the early Christian communities about how they carried the message of the resurrected Lord to all the lands. We too are reminded that the Lord continues to be with us. Through the words of scripture and through the sacraments, let us rekindle ourselves with the Easter flame that never dies because we all are fed from the flame that conquers death.

Recruitment: This coming July marks one year since my arrival in Yankton. As many of you are aware, I am responsible for the Liturgical Environment for both parishes. My hope is to create a group primarily to plan and enhance the beatification for both parishes. If you were part of this decoration group during Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter, or want to be part of this group, please contact me for more details.
