

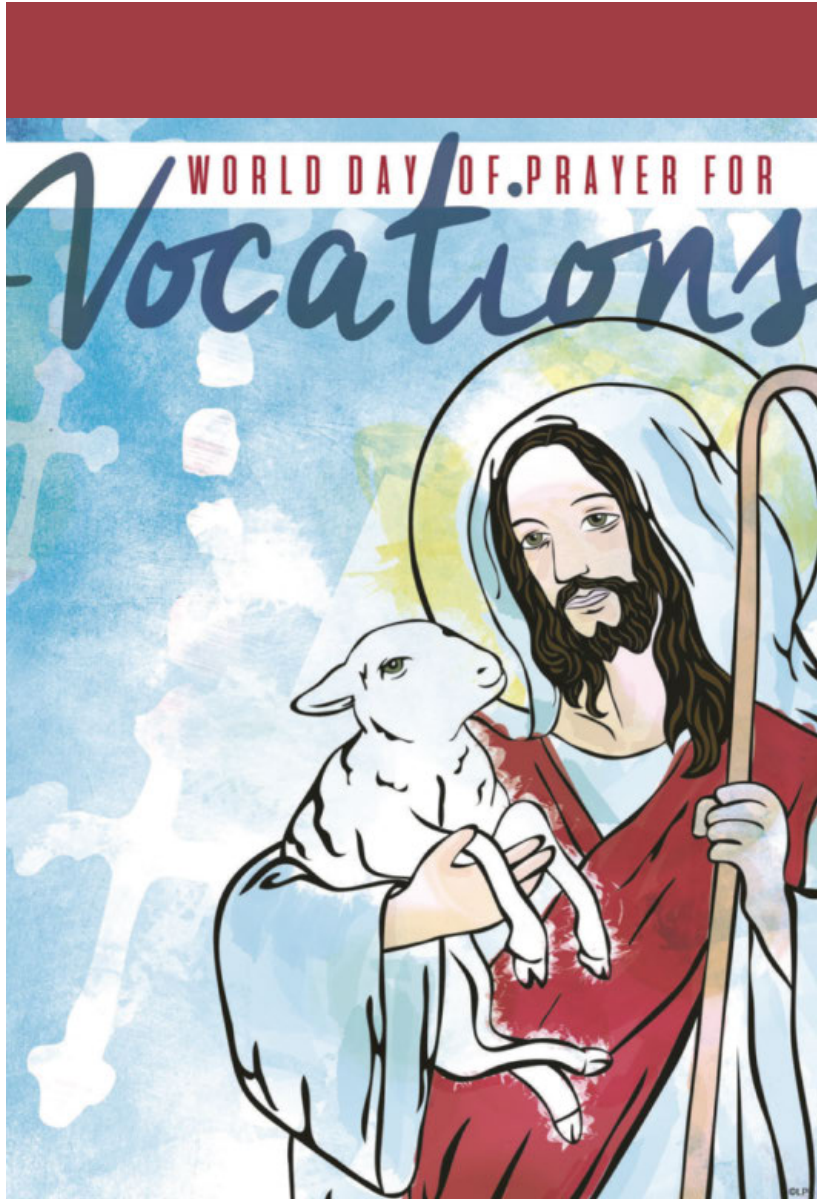

Two little neighbor kids were visiting us on a recent, misty, cold day. They were typical kiddos: tough and not thinking about too much, even the cold, until it was on them.

Interrupting our conversation was a woman’s loud shout: “What are you doing? Get back inside!”

Meekly the two sprites turned around, one trotting, the other riding her tricycle to go back home.

I looked to Fr. Grant – he and I had both been on the receiving end of our mothers – and he said with a chuckle: “Formation!” I smiled back in deep agreement.

When he and I think “Formation,” we often refer to our time in seminary where Human, Intellectual, Pastoral, and Spiritual formation occurs with regular and profound intentionality.

Seminary is that time and space where men are formed by Mother Church to be the Fathers for her children by Baptism. It is the place where men discern their call to be spiritual fathers.

The Postulancy and Novitiate are the analogous places for women discerning a call to be the spouse of Jesus Christ and his mystical body, the Church.

From both the religious house and seminary come good mothers and fathers – some called to be “Mom” and “Dad” or “Mother” and “Father” as they walk the journey of discernment.

Where do these calls of discernment all start, however? In the home. The family is the domestic church and mothers are very often the lead formators of the sanctuary of the home. With the father, they aid the members to know peace, tranquility, self-control, social skills, responsibility, personal care, awe, wonder, and worship.

Consider the experience of Paul and Barnabas – it is your own. They arrived to proclaim the Good News in Antioch – to inform the residents of the person of Jesus Christ! There, though the whole town was gathered, ‘women of prominence’ and ‘leading men of the city,’ stirred up a persecution against them.

Paul and Barnabas faced steep resistance to the formation they offered in the Spiritual life. Moms and dads, you lead your little congregations in human, intellectual, pastoral, and spiritual growth. Be not surprised by occasional resistance. Lead them to Jesus’ sweetness by your own. Guide and form them with your love.

For you who are Moms – and Dads – you are essential to the very fabric of society and the foundation of the mystical body of the Church. You are doing a work for which no one else is capable and in which no one else will receive such specific graces to accomplish. Do not be surprised at the effort – Formation!

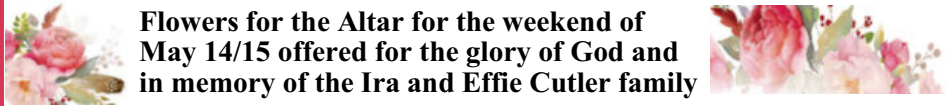

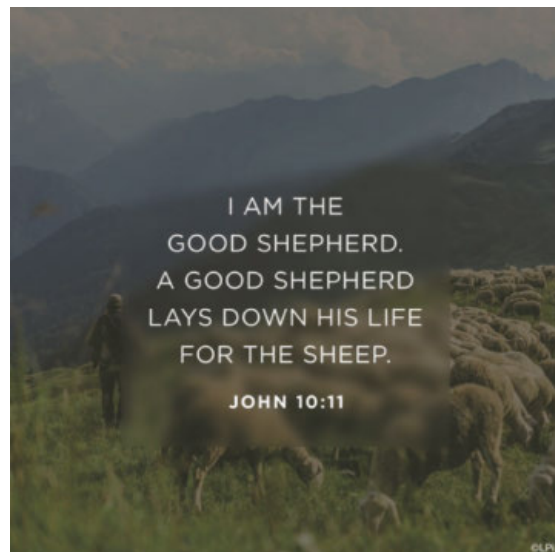
