Times for Housekeeping



May is the Month of Mary: Join us Wednesday, May 25th at 6pm as we celebrate Mary's gift of the rosary with a "Celebrate the Rosary Social". The evening will include: Rosary Makers demonstration, including the opportunity for children to complete and take home a rosary; Short video; Children's activities; Seven Sorrows rosary display; and a Short presentation on the Family Radio Rosary and on volunteer opportunities to pray the rosary. Refreshments will be provided.

Memorial Day: This day we honor all of our Veterans who have sacrificed their lives to protect our freedom and our democracy and we call them "Heroes". This day we thank them for their service. If they have already entered into eternal reward, it is customary that we go to the cemetery, clean their tombstones decorate with flowers and with the American Flag. In our Catholic Faith, we honor those who have gone before us who are our role models and have shaped and formed us. We also call them "Heroes," living or deceased, and remember them.

On Memorial Day we will have an outdoor Mass by the large Crucifix at 8:30AM - please bring your lawn chairs and be ready to praise the Lord for all our Heroes.

Summer Vacation: Just a gentle reminder as your family is planning for vacation, be sure to check out the churches and their Mass schedules at your destination. God never takes a vacation and we should not take a vacation from God. Also please remember to continue to support our church family with your weekly offering.

Corpus Christi/Father's Day-June 19: This day we celebrate Jesus truly present in the Holy Eucharist at all of our Masses as normal, but at Sacred Heart after the 11AM Mass we will have a Eucharistic Caravan to St. Ben's where we will have a procession of the Holy Eucharist into the church, and a short period of Adoration/Benediction.
