

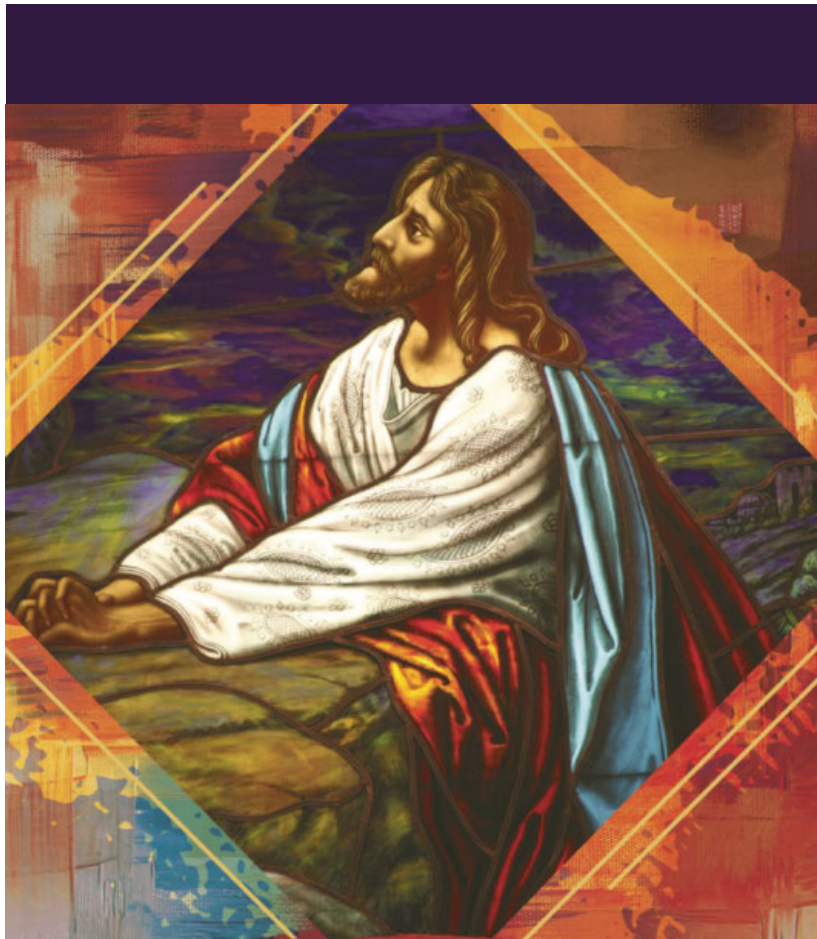

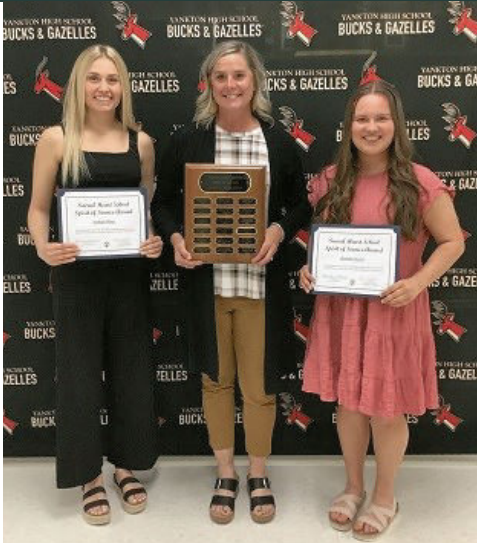

◆◆ PRIEST'S MESSAGE ◆◆

Sacred Heart Cemetery is the property of Sacred Heart Church. The property consists of two parcels. The first parcel, the current location of the Cemetery, is 10.6 acres. That property was acquired in 1881, the inception of the Cemetery. Approximately 3,760 Catholic souls are buried there. That location currently has about 700 burial plots available to be sold. At the current burial rate, that will suffice for another 30-40 years. The other parcel directly north of the current Cemetery property was purchased by Sacred Heart Church in 1948. That parcel is 20.4 acres and has not been plotted for burial use at this time. It is estimated that that property would be sufficient to meet burial needs of the Yankton Catholic community for several hundred years. Approximately 30-35 parishioners of Sacred Heart Church, St. Benedict Church and other related Catholic souls are buried in the Cemetery annually.

The Cemetery is overseen by a board of 5 parishioners from our local Catholic churches, with the current pastor serving as Chairman. The board meets twice a year and occasionally more frequently if the need arises. Maintenance of the Cemetery is overseen by one of the board members on a volunteer basis. One board member also volunteers to coordinate burials with families, the grave excavator, and the funeral homes. There is one paid employee of the Cemetery who is employed approximately 6-7 months per year. Much of the maintenance of the Cemetery is performed by volunteers of the churches. The Knights of Columbus and Catholic Daughters of America also play a key role in volunteer maintenance functions at the Cemetery. In recent years there have been about 40 volunteers that have stepped up to assist with mowing, tree trimming, removal and replacement, weed suppression, flower planting as well as water application as needed. Grave excavation and filling is completed by an outside person on a contract basis.

The current expense budget to maintain the Cemetery is approximately \$62,000 per year. The costs to maintain the Cemetery are covered partially by current sale of cemetery plots and burial fees, with the remaining coming from memorials, donations and reserves. There are approximately \$220,000 of reserve funds available for the Cemetery. These reserves are designated to maintain the Cemetery property as a fitting resting place for Catholic souls in perpetuity. These funds would also be used to develop the north parcel for future Cemetery use at the appropriate time.
