

When I was a little guy, Mom baked a rabbit-shaped, shredded coconut covered birthday cake for me. She made it from two round cakes. One was his face, the other was cut so that two outside 'ovals' became the ears and the middle portion was his bowtie. The imprint of that cake remains strong with me. I still enjoy shredded coconut today!

Jesus' Resurrection is also imprinted strongly in my mind. It is a sublime imprinting as well. He has imbued it into the very thought processes and practical attitudes of my nurturing. Take for example, the thought of death: when an animal died, it was no big deal; but when someone we knew died, we prayed for them with sadness and yet a confidence that death was not the end.

The power of Jesus' Resurrection is to be embraced with GREAT JOY. It is not an imprinting to be casually enjoyed as if it is just there. We again need the deep joy and great surprise of the early Church! Again and again, we will hear their stories through this Easter season. You and I are invited to bask again in the re-telling of this family heritage.

Jesus dies and rises again and again in your life and my life! Has he surprised you lately? Does Mary Magdalene's urgency and confusion "We don't know where they laid him?" resonate with you?

The disheartened disciples on the road to Emmaus ask Jesus: "Are you the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know of the things that have taken place there in these days?" When you and I are downcast, can we ask Jesus a similar, insistent question?

I hope and pray that you and I will tell Jesus of the Thoughts, Feelings, and Desires that are rolling around our hearts. I hope we relate the TFD's to him so that the surprise of Emmaus will ALSO become ours: "Were not our hearts burning within us?"

May your Easter be far from common, far from typical. May the Easter Eggs and bitten off chocolate bunny ears prompt you to talk about ~ the Surprise of JOY you have experienced in Jesus.

St. Martin of Tours Pastorate

Something unique to this area of our diocese is that Yankton was the original capital of the Dakota Territory when Bishop Martin Marty first became its apostolic vicar in 1879. Before that,



Bishop Marty was a Benedictine Abbot for Saint Meinrad in Indiana who volunteered to become a missionary at Standing Rock. The Benedictine sisters at Sacred Heart Monastery (Yankton) preserve many relics from the first Bishop of our diocese.

It was not until 1889 when South Dakota became a State that Sioux Falls was then named as the episcopal see city for the new diocese.

The namesake of Bishop Marty was most likely Saint Martin of Tours (†397). Fr. Schmidt


