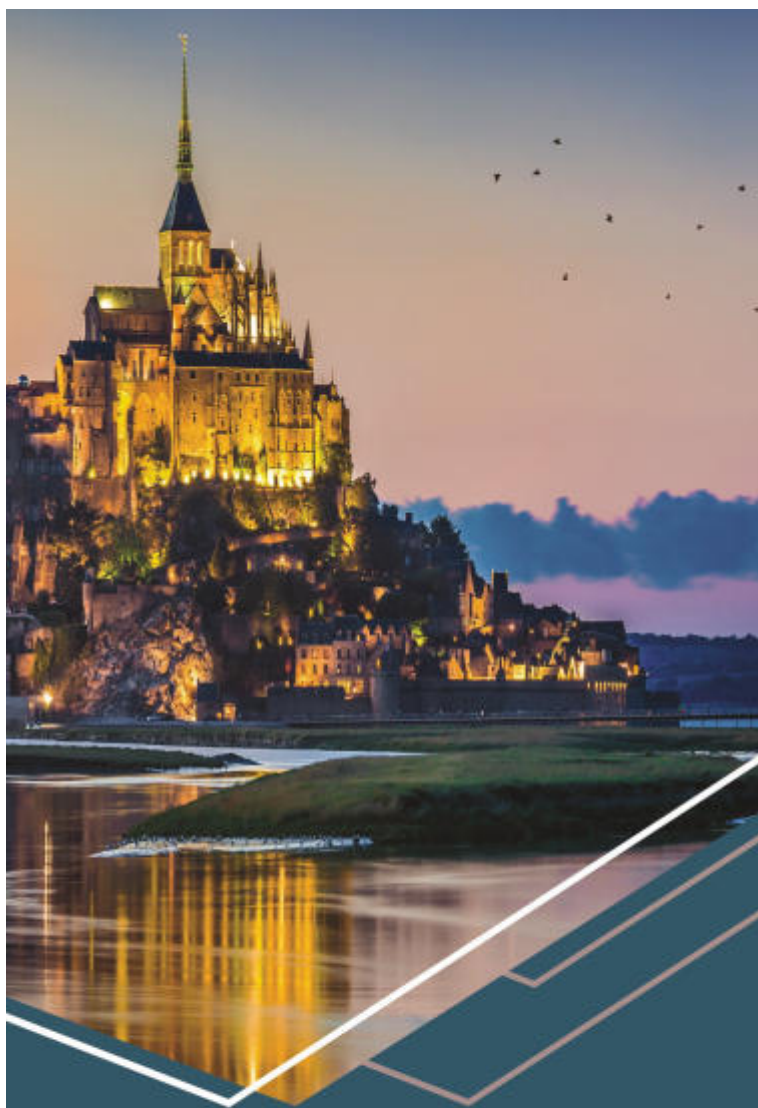

Service and Community.....the recent Pro-Life breakfast was not all about Service, there was also a bit of Community mixed in.

Community: the work we do together.
If you have helped at any parish event you know the number of workers it takes to pull it off. When the crowd was light, workers were able to visit with those dining. As Mass ended, the tables filled. Suddenly the stairs filled again. Something happened then that would warm your heart. Those waiting brought in more tables and chairs. Many brought dishes back to the dish bucket when they were done eating. Many stepped up to help. Regardless of the size of the crowd, everyone seemed to linger and talk.

This positive experience recharged my batteries!

We are reading Matthew Chapter 5 from now until Lent. Chapter 5 starts with the Sermon on the Mount, when Jesus taught us the Beatitudes. Today we learn more about the simile of 'salt and light' – we are to influence the world through good deeds.
Sound simple; easy?

Good deeds don't happen because we schedule them. Good deeds happen every day. I think many of us can recall when a kind word or deed left an impact on our life.

Looking back to the breakfast, is everyone comfortable stepping forward to help? Like the beggar or the enemy, all of us need to be wanted and needed.

A reference from the internet yielded a quote worth sharing. "The world has too many areas of darkness that need our light – even though we may sometimes feel like our batteries are running out". (eCatholicism.org).

How do we recharge our batteries so we can continue to provide light? In addition to Mass and prayer, I need to connect with others. The Walleye Fry at Tintah (February 28th) sounds like a plan; I hear the fish is good.
