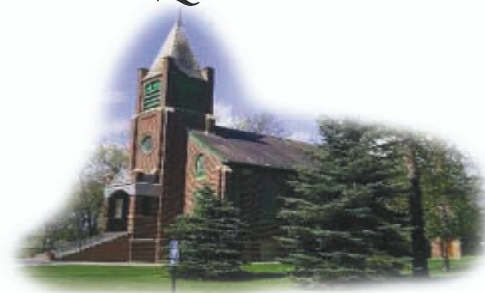

Carrying our Baptismal Ministry into Lent

The practice of fasting, abstinence, almsgiving and prayer prepares us to renew our baptismal promises at Easter. The 40-day period of Lent is also when those who will be entering the church, the Elect, take the final stages in preparation for their baptism. How can we journey to Easter using our roles as Priest, Prophet, and King?

Priest

The traditional role of priest was to offer sacrifice. In our Lenten journey we are called to work towards a more Inclusive and welcoming community. Those coming to our table should feel connected as we share our faith.

Prophet

Prophets in scripture stood up for orphans and widows. The prophet often inspired ordinary people to move from smugness or satisfaction into action. During Lent we are encouraged to be involved in solutions rather than blaming others. As we live and work in the secular world, we are able to reach people outside the physical walls of the church.

King

Most think of a king as someone with power and authority over others. Jesus encouraged his disciples to be servants to all. Characteristics of a servant leader include humility, listener, attentive, responsive. As disciples we are called to see the smallest needs of those among us, starting at home, moving out to our neighbor and then to the world.

Where to Start

Lent is a time of spiritual growth for all of us. One may decide to grow their prayer life. Others may fast from behaviors that prevent us from achieving goals or adopt habits that better serve our family and community. Humans are created for community, both in kinship and in culture. Collaborating within our Area Catholic Community builds community.
