



AREA CATHOLIC COMMUNITIES

Articles in the tenth month of the year of St. Joseph focus on him as the protector of the Holy Family. At the advice of an angel, a pregnant Mary is accepted as his wife. After the birth of Jesus and adoration by the Magi, another dream orders Joseph to take his family to Egypt for safety. Only after the death of Herrod does the family return to their home country, specifically to Nazareth. We cannot sum up Joseph in one word. In addition to protector, be Joseph is described as defender. His qualities include gentleness and tenderness, as well as a man of silence.

October is also Respect Life Month. We look to St. Joseph as an example of our call to protect, safeguard and defend God's gift of human life. In 1995 Pope St. John Paul II wrote an encyclical called the "Gospel of Life". In addition to threats including abortion and euthanasia, John Paul expands on other threats that seem justified by human law. How do we protect?

We remember that:
