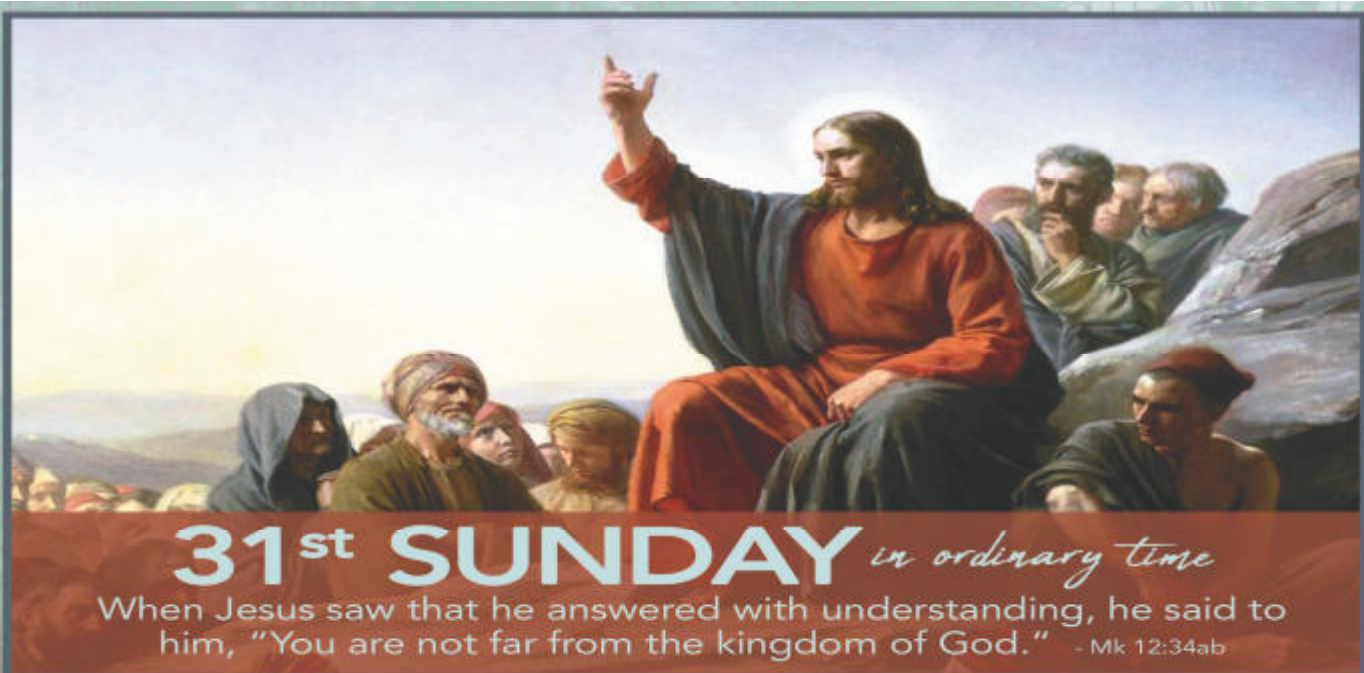

In the September issue of 'the WORD among us', the author is asked by a young child to explain why her brother has autism. Using the word 'mystery', the child is told her life would be enriched because of her love for her brother. A phrase from a 19<sup>th</sup> century philosopher adds "Life is not so much a problem to be solved as a mystery to be lived".

We walk through one of the greatest mysteries every time we attend Mass. When we receive communion, we take that mystery into our body and then into our hearts.

Mass also includes readings from the Bible. The Bible: rich in stories and prayers. We join together to sing psalms. There are many words demonstrating God's gift of life. The earth was formless and dark until God spoke "Let there be light".

The last phrase of Matthew 28:20 states "and behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age". This promise made by Jesus is fulfilled on Pentecost.

The Holy Spirit empowers us to fulfill the ministry of Jesus. We use the gifts of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. These are our tools.

The two-year process of the Synod starts with listening, but includes prayer and discernment. We will be invited to participate in the process. We must dare to become closer to Jesus and one another during this journey.
