

Red River Valley ACC

The word 'tapestry' has crept into many articles recently. Two definitions from an online dictionary stand out. First; a tapestry is a woven fabric with complex pictures used in large settings. Cold, drafty medieval castles used tapestries not only to cover stone walls, but for warmth. Second; tapestry is used to describe complex combinations such as a 'tapestry of cultures, customs or relationships'. In one article, the 'many threads' of a tapestry was used to describe marriage. A tapestry is woven. Midway through today's second reading; we hear what is often referred to as the love chapter of the Bible, 1 Corinthians 13. Often used at weddings, verse 4 starts with 'love is patient, love is kind', going on to list nine characteristics of love. St. Paul wrote this detailed list during a time when the people were troubled. People were struggling with the concept of faith, hope and love. How do we weave the virtue of love into our life? Whatever we do, we are called to participate in the mission of Jesus Christ. By our Baptism, along with the cardinal virtues of faith, hope and love, we are called. When we look at the tapestry of our life, we see the messy back side, full of knots, frayed ends and unorganized color. We don't see what God, the weaver, sees.

How do we find our way in a complex world? Examples can be found in surprising places. Catholic School's week lists a focus for each day, including community, students, nation, vocation, staff and family. Can we focus our life day by day?

As we end each day with prayers of gratitude, we can ask that the morning brings us ways to hear and respond to God's call. God knows us. God is the weaver of our life, starting long before our birth.
