First Sunday of Lent

The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert, and he remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan. He was among the beasts, and the angels ministered to him. Mark 1:12-13

When I entered treatment in 2015 for alcoholism, a friend of mine called to support me. He said, "We all have our demons." Those were comforting words to me even though it may sound strange.

Jesus' temptations in the desert for forty days is a clear reference to the 40 years of the Israelites in the desert after being driven out of Egypt, just like the Spirit 'drove' Jesus into the desert. The Israelites went through many temptations in their desert time and confronted many demons/satans. While Satan certainly is a spiritual being, a fallen angel, he can use any and all of our personal weaknesses, our diseases, and many other ways to be our adversary, which is another word for Satan. Remember Jesus called St. Peter a 'Satan', when he said, "Get behind me Satan, you are thinking as man does and not God." And St. Paul said that Satan takes on many forms and can even appear as an angel of light.

Perhaps go through the Seven Deadly Sins and pray about our personal behaviors or addictions. How is Satan being an adversary to us by using our sinful preponderance to lead us away from the light of Christ?
