Laetare Sunday

Laetare is Latin for "rejoice," the first word in today's entrance antiphon: "Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning. . ." (*Isaiah 66:10*). The priest wears a rose vestment as we "express hope and joy in the midst of our Lenten penances."

Mothering Sunday

Since the Middle Ages, this is traditionally a day to honor and visit one's mother church, which is the church of one's baptism. St. Paul's words in today's liturgy are the source of this concept: "that Jerusalem which is above. . .which is our mother." simplycatholic.com
