

Fifth Sunday of Lent

"...not having any righteousness of my own based on the law but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God,..." Phil. 3

"Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." Again he bent down and wrote on the ground. And in response, they went away one by one, beginning with the elders."

John 8

The wisdom of Jesus in this Sunday's story of the person caught in adultery demonstrates the difficulty we have in admitting our own sinfulness, especially when we are forced to face our own sins.

Jesus forced the elders and everyone with them to face and to admit their own sinfulness and unworthiness of salvation. Their initial intent to condemn the adulterer keeps at bay any reference to sin on their part. Jesus catches them in their own trap.

When it comes to the law, we all are guilty and worthy of death. Only by humbly confessing our sins and professing our faith in salvation through Christ are we made righteous for eternal life.
