PASTOR'S CORNER

"Simon, Simon, behold Satan has demanded to sift all of you like wheat, but I have prayed that your own faith may not fail; and once you have turned back, you must strengthen your brothers."

This quote from today's gospel for Palm Sunday is a very encouraging scene for all of us. Jesus is preparing Peter and the other apostles for what is to come, something they cannot even imagine: that they all will deny and abandon him.

Maybe you can identify with the denial scene. I know I can. I recall times when I distanced myself from someone's behavior stating that I would never do that, only later to do the same thing or something similar.

The key point of this story is that all of us sin, no matter how much we want to deny it. When and how I recover from sin is the most important message in Peter's denial.

All of us, including saints, "...have sinned and are deprived of the glory of God." What stands out about saints is that, when they sin, they get back up, acknowledge their sin, and seek forgiveness in the sacrament of Reconciliation.

Do I get back up, acknowledge my sin, and seek Reconciliation from Christ our Savior? When I do this, then I can strengthen others.
