The first reading speaks to us of the wonder and power of the Lord. We are called to praise the Lord, our God. In the second reading, Paul says "Just one thing: forgetting what lies behind but straining forward to what lies ahead. . .toward the prize of God's upward

calling. . ." It is indeed a blessing that we can trust in God's forgiveness of what lies behind us and instead use all of our energy toward what lies ahead with Christ Jesus. Is this not one example of Easter joy?
