St Anthony Pax Christi Nominee: Barb Lynch

In 1960 Bishop Hammes updated the earlier "Mother of the Year" award to the "Pax Christi Medal". Which means Peace of Christ. This award recognizes devout, hard working Christian women within our parishes. It is a way to honor women who live their faith as an example for everyone. The Pax Christi Committee chooses 5 finalists, one from each Deanery. The finalists' dossiers are sent to the Bishop, who selects the winner. The winner is announced at the annual Superior Diocese Council of Catholic Women Convention in June this year. For 2022, St. Anthony the Abbot Parish the Pax Christi award nominee is Barb Lynch. Barb and her husband Dave have been married for 48 years and have raised 3 loving and loyal sons. She is grandma to 6 grandchildren and she and her husband are closely involved in their lives.

To highlight some of her accomplishments:

Barb diligently serves our church community as an active member of the CCW. She has held the positions of Vice President and President as well as circle leader. Throughout the decades, she has demonstrated a commitment to service by participating in fund raisers, helping in the kitchen for funerals, counting money, supporting the children's Christmas program, and serving as a greeter. She has enhanced the spiritual growth of our youth by teaching religious education, preparing 2nd graders for First Holy Communion, and taught 6th graders and sophomores. She is a confirmation sponsor for 10 individuals, attends retreats, supports Food for the Poor, executes a personal daily bible study, and keeps a rosary with her at all times. She is a shining example of a faithful Catholic who works alongside others, offering her heart and hands to build faith, inspire hope and ignite change. Barb willingly steps up when help is needed. Her calm presence is contagious and appreciated. She radiates and reveals the light of Christ and seeks no recognition for herself.

She is an original board member of our local Education Foundation and supporter of the annual foundation fundraiser banquet. She was a member of the executive committee working with the human relations arm of the Northwest United Educators. She was also a unit director and on the negotiation team. She helped organize the education fair held in a nearby mall. She has mentored two children through the Kinship program and has helped with fundraisers for the organization. Her creativity is witnessed through her participation in the theater. She was a Board of Director for a theater in the adjacent town acting there for over 20 years. Currently she volunteers at the hospital in Cumberland. How fortunate our church and community are to have such a devoted, God centered woman in our midst. She inspires others to greater service and giving. We thank God and praise Him for gracing us with such an energetic, joyful giver.


