Scriptures: Isaiah 55:10-11, Letter of St. Paul to the Romans 8:18-23 and Gospel according to Matthew 13:1-23

In the first reading, I am left thinking about how we receive the word of God and how the word impacts our earthy lives. The question I ask myself is what am I doing with the wisdom of the word of God, am I nourishing creation around me? How does my life make a difference for my family, friends and neighbors? How does my life affect creation/nature? In the second reading, as in the past two weeks I again feel the promise of hope in times of pain. We may experience labor pains on this earth but we are made aware that we will experience joy as children of God in the redemption of our bodies. In the gospel, we again come back to the "word of God" as it falls upon us in our earthly lives. The question we need to ask ourselves is "what kind of soil am I?" Am I open to the word of God? Do I live the word of God in my daily life? Is my life providing nurturing soil for the generations to come? This week spend some time reflecting on how the word of God has impacted your life.
