## Mission Co-Op Appeal

Rev. Eugene Inobeme, OSA will be celebrating mass with us on behalf of the Ad Gentes Missionary Congregation who works in the countries of Bukina Faso, Cameroon, Nigeria, and the USA. Father Inobeme is a priest of the Order of St. Augustine affiliated to the Province of St. Augustine of Nigeria, and he is currently studying Christian Spirituality at Creighton University in Omaha.

Ad Gentes is committed to the development of people through human, agricultural and community building. They embrace a life of prayer, community living, and service through ministries in education, healthcare, community development, and inter-religious and cultural dialogue. In particular, the recent violent attack of the Bioko Haram and Jihadists bandits was close to the convent home of the sisters in the north central region of Nigeria. The ten nuns and the novices were forced to flee and take shelter in a convent school. The fear of being abused, harmed, raped, or kidnapped is a very real concern for them. They are pleading for our support to help us keep their convent safe and continue to provide alternative education, skills, literacy, and vocational training, as well as community development.

While for most of you, she needs no introduction, we would like to welcome Jan Kunz to the official staff of the Parishes of Western Holt & Boyd Counties. She has lived in Stuart for 32 years, worked for St. Boniface School from 1989-2008, and she has been the Director of Ministries at St. Boniface Stuart since 2008. She also worked for the archdiocese as the Rural Coordinator of Evangelization and Catechesis from 2008-2016. Beginning July 1, Jan will be moving into the position of Director of Evangelization and Catechesis for all 5 parishes. She will be responsible for the development, implementation, evaluation, and ongoing improvement of ministry programs, bible studies, and other ways to engage the parishes & communities.

## Steubenville Youth Conference

We have 21 youth, young adults, and adult chaperones attending the Steubenville Youth Conference in Springfield Missouri on July 8-10. They will be traveling with a group of parishes on busses leaving from Norfolk on July 8. Thousands of Catholic high school students will be gathering together on the campus of Missouri State University to grow in their relationship with the Lord, and celebrating their Catholic faith with excellent musicians, speakers, the sacraments, small group time, and tons of fun. Due to some communication challenges, we are still working on fundraising for this event. It costs \$350 per student for them to attend this event, and we have asked each student to only pay \$175 (half) of this amount. Dear Parishioners and Friends of the Catholic Parishes of Western Holt and Boyd Counties,

The Family of Parishes Pastoral Planning Team (made up with representatives of each parish in our grouping) held their first meeting in June. We thank the following people for being willing to serve as team members in this process: St. Joseph Amelia — Gina Pospichal, Brant Pavel, Rick Doolittle; St. Joseph Atkinson —Patti Skrdla, Don Slaymaker, Linda Wolf; Sacred Heart Boyd County —Mary Haun, Mary Eiler, Marge Nolan; St. Patrick O’Neill — Nancy Berg, Shad Thompson, Keith Willis; St. Boniface Stuart —Jonna Kohl, Tracy Ludwig, Rick Shearer, and Ex-Officio: Fr. Starman, Fr. Burkhalter, Dcn. Kersenbrock, and Jan Kunz. It was probably the most difficult of all the meetings we will have because I gave them the task of determining a reasonable and doable weekend Mass schedule adhering to the parameters set forth by Archbishop Lucas in late May.

A priest is allowed to celebrate up to 4 masses per weekend at up to **two locations**.

No parishioner should have to travel more than 20 miles one way to attend Mass.

After nearly 2 hours of discussion the team came to consensus. Beginning July 1, 2022, our weekend Masses will be as follows:

**St. Boniface – Stuart: Saturday, 5:00 p.m.**

**St. Joseph – Atkinson: Sunday, 9:00 a.m.**

**St. Joseph – Amelia: Sunday, 11:15 a.m.**

**St. Patrick – O’Neill: Saturday, 5:00 p.m. Sunday, 10:30 a.m.**

While it’s not a perfect resolution we feel it is workable. Bear in mind that Fr. Burkhalter and I will not be able to attend wedding receptions, parishes breakfasts, or other parish functions in the future. Nor will we in most cases be able to stay around and greet people after most of the Masses as the time is limited to get to the next location. We also will not have the flexibility to adapt Mass times for special occasions in our communities as we have in the past.

Also, this is what we are implementing beginning July 1<sup>st</sup>. However, when it is submitted to Archbishop Lucas with the rest of our completed plan in mid-November, he could reject the schedule and tell us to start over.

The Family of Parishes Pastoral Planning Team will continue to meet for the next several months and we will do our best to keep everyone informed of the progress that’s being made. Pray for us.
