
Dear Parishioners and Friends of the Catholic Parishes of Western Holt and Boyd Counties,

This weekend's gospel (Luke 13: 22-30) opens with a reminder that Jesus is still journeying to Jerusalem, answering questions and telling stories along the way to explain what is expected of a disciple. "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" asks some-one—no doubt with the unspoken hope "along with me!" The anonymity of the questioner drags us all into both the question and Jesus's reply. This reply is not a direct answer, but a parable about the effort needed to be saved. Central to the parable is the image of the narrow door. It is not a locked door, but one that requires disciples to give up self-indulgent ways and go into a spiritual training program that will slim us down and enable us to pass through this door into the kingdom. The media is full of stories about the demanding regime athletes must follow in their training. To squeeze into a sports team, especially as a representative of one's country, is a cause for celebration; to be citizens who squeeze into the kingdom of God (Phil 3:20) is an eternal joy beyond compare. It is in Jerusalem, where Jesus is heading to suffer, that the narrow door of salvation will be forced sufficiently wide for us by his crucified and risen body.

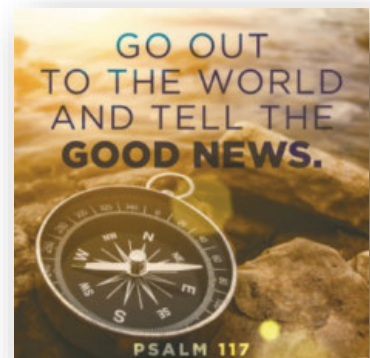
The Letter to the Hebrews maintains that for the spiritual olympiad, suffering is part of our training. Flagging disciples must never lose sight of Jesus and his endurance of the cross if they, too, are to endure in the face of hostility from without and lack of commitment from within themselves and their community. In an era when we are made privy to all the details of an injured sport hero's physical therapy routine ("punishing," as it is often described!), we need to reflect on our own routines for enduring the kingdom race as we strive to reach heaven.

The second image in the gospel, the second door, is a locked one. The door to the kingdom of God will not remain open forever. There comes a time when, for each one of us personally in death, and cosmically at the second coming of Christ, the door will be closed. Jesus, the risen Christ, is the Master of God's household who "arises" to shut the door. He will not open it to name-dropping or pleas of casual associates who by their protests only indicate how shallow their relationship with Jesus has been. In fact, says the gospel, Jesus will be busy at the back door with those who are too ashamed to come to the front: the strangers, the beggars, those healed in their bodies and psyches, the abused women, the repentant sinners, and all those who may not have known much about God. But they were known by God as the last who deserved to be first in the kingdom. This is a scene of gospel reversal, with graphic language to impress on Jesus's audience that those who expect to be the guests at the messianic banquet, who considered themselves holy, may be disappointed. They will have no place in the history of salvation and will not sit at table with Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and all the prophets; others will take their place. We should remember that Jesus's words are admonitions rather than predictions. If we are honest with ourselves, especially our self-righteous selves, we will admit that we still find it rather scandalous and upsetting that "those people," with their contemporary name tags we choose to write and their categorizations we describe, might be invited into the feast—or at least have a more favored place at table than we do.
