



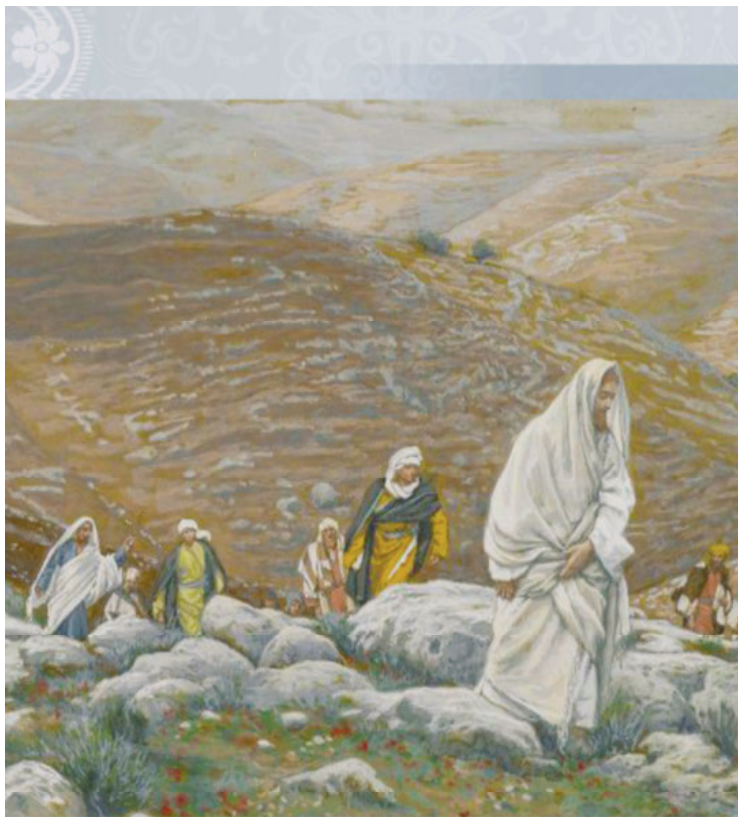

The average size of a BRISKET: twenty pounds (precooked), even larger than last years' briskets! Can cut into 4 - 5 pieces and use for 4 - 5 meals! 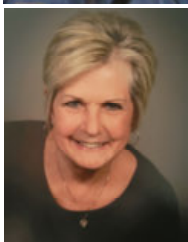
