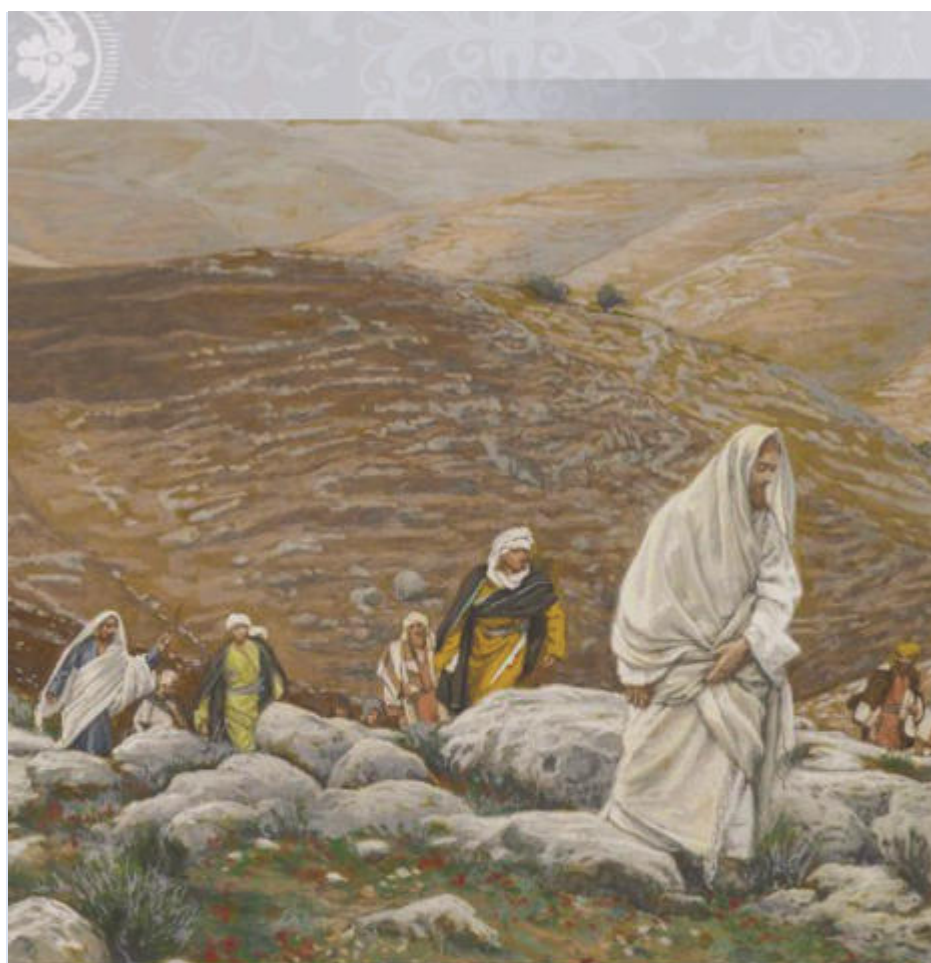

A Message From Fr. Kris Fourth Sunday In Ordinary Time

In our readings this weekend, we hear from the Prophet Jeremiah who speaks of God's plan for the lives of those who follow Him. We're reminded that, even before we were born, while still being formed in the womb, God knew us and had a plan for our lives. Jeremiah was reflecting on His life as a prophet, as one sent to proclaim God's saving message. While he did find peace and joy, he also found that following the Lord isn't easy. Along with the joy that comes from following the Lord, Jeremiah found that following Him also has some pretty substantial challenges and difficulties.

Jeremiah reminded his listeners, that in the face of the difficulties, to rely on God who promised to strengthen us in our struggles. Take courage and trust in the Lord. It is He who strengthens us. In the Gospel this weekend, we hear Jesus preaching in His hometown. We hear that Jesus had difficulty working miracles there because of their lack of faith. I would surmise that they didn't trust Him because they thought they knew Him.

In alluding to the hardships that He would face, Jesus reminds His disciples (and us) that following Him won't be the easiest path. We will face trials and persecutions. Our faith will be challenged and tested. But, we also know that where the Master has gone, we too will go. While we face trials and struggles, we know that the Lord has been there before us, and that He walks with us. Thankfully, He draws us in to a relationship with Himself, and strengthens us for His mission. Often, He only shows us the next step on the path, for if we knew the adventure we were about to enter, we might balk!

In many ways, our second reading from St. Paul's first Letter to the Corinthians at this weekend's Masses has a similar effect. We hear the words that "Love is patient, and love is kind." Our first response is probably something of affinity. The words sound good, they are something we like to hear. This is one of the more common readings at weddings and has a nice "ring" to it! Then, we notice that Paul didn't qualify his words. He didn't say that we should only love those who love us, or that we should only be patient with those who are easy to get along with.

We find ourselves at once drawn in and challenged. We like the way the words sound, but then realize that we don't like to be patient; we find that being kind and loving is not an easy command to follow. Love, in reality, is difficult! It's a choice we make, and often have to recommit ourselves to living lives of Christian charity. Paul is reminding his hearers that they are to be Christ's loving presence to the world and to imitate His love.

Like Jeremiah, though, we find ourselves drawn in and challenged. We find that, often, God only lets us in on the next step, or what we should be doing right now. God draws us in, then calls us to follow His ways one step at a time. St. Paul was reminding the Church in Corinth that they (and we) are to live Christ's love in our daily lives. Our challenge in all of this is to *take up the cross* and follow Jesus, being His presence to the world. Follow the Master through the Cross to the Resurrection. Difficult, yes, but even more rewarding for all eternity!
