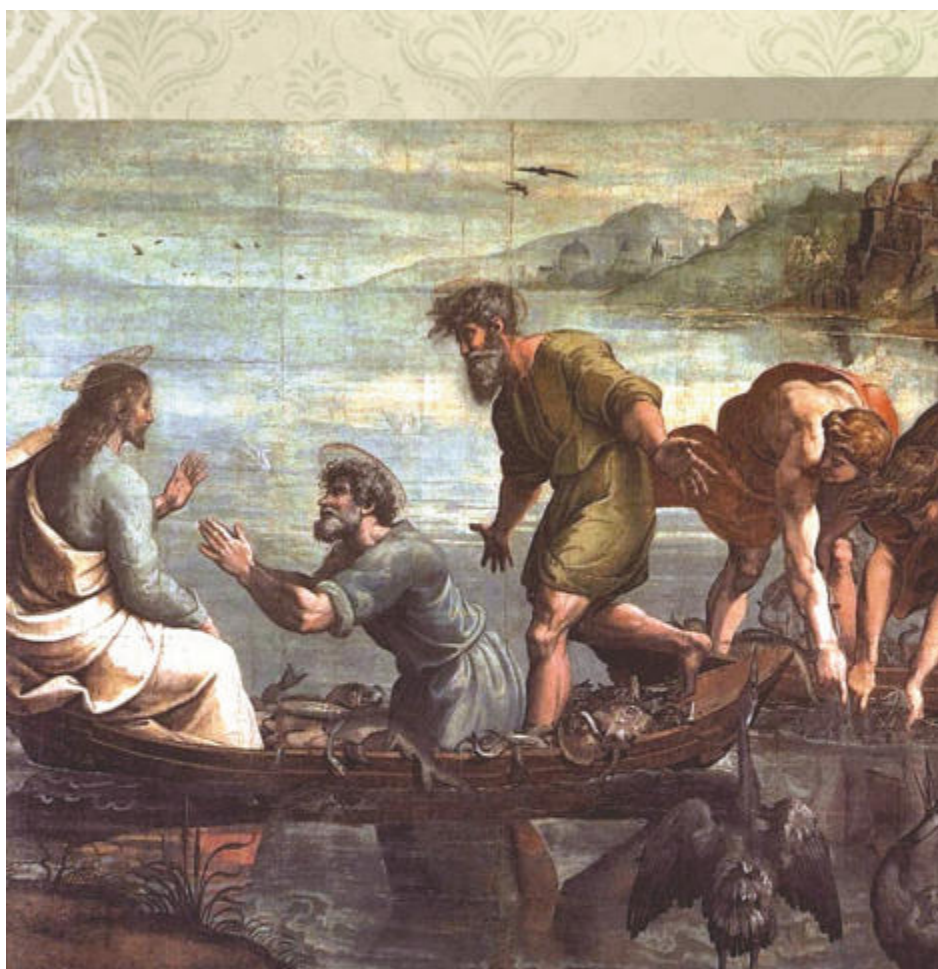

A Message From Fr. Kris Fifth Sunday In Ordinary Time

Recently I heard a Catholic Podcast on how to pray the Mass more deeply. As I listened intently to Fr. Mike speaking of the Mass as worship during a talk given to college students, I couldn't help but feel a sense of gratitude. After all, this is good information! It's always good to hear those reminders that the Mass isn't about us and all the prayers are directed to the Father, through the Son, in the Holy Spirit.

Interestingly, over the past few years, I've seen a growing trend. Many of the people aren't so much looking for "what I can get out of Mass" (since we all know that we "get" Jesus, which is a gift beyond our understanding or perception) but rather, "how can I give myself more fully over to the Lord?" through the Mass. There is a renewed sense that the Mass isn't about us, or what we can do, but rather what God can do through us and a deep realization that a self-focused life (and self-focused worship) is largely unfulfilling.

The Mass, is the highest form of worship that we can offer to God. We give back to Him (in the Eucharist) what He first gave to us... and, when we think about it, all the good things in our lives, all our gifts and talents, are all gifts from God. The least we can do is use those gifts in His service, while being grateful that He allows us to take part in the great mystery of salvation.

The Sign of the Cross reminds us of our Baptism and to whom we belong. We were purchased at a great price. We ask God's mercy and forgiveness for those times we haven't lived up to the great dignity that has been bestowed on us in the Penitential Rite, and then offer the Gloria—note that we say or sing "Glory to God". We give glory to Him, and not to ourselves. We hear from the Sacred Scriptures about God's saving work and the economy of salvation. God has done so much for us.

We hear a homily that (hopefully) builds us up in the faith while challenging us to a deeper conversion of heart. The Creed follows, where we profess our belief in the Triune God, while bowing in reverence for the words "and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man." Everything we do, say and even think, should bring us back to the Incarnation of Christ and remind us that He took on humanity in order to redeem it.

In the Eucharistic Prayers offered by the priest, a few dollars' worth of bread and wine are changed (transubstantiation) into the Lord's body, blood, soul, and divinity. He's simultaneously closer to us than we to ourselves in giving Himself to us under the appearance of ordinary food, and mysteriously distant as He is infinitely above our thoughts. We receive the Lord, and are sent forth to glorify the Lord with our lives, having been strengthened by the Bread from Heaven.

Through all of this, we begin to realize that while we're at Mass, we're invited to take part in the deep mystery of the Heavenly Liturgy, that we worship God not for our own sake but for His, while in return, we are given a gift greater than our minds can fathom. Our challenge is to live for the Lord in happiness and peace with our hearts and minds focused on Him!
