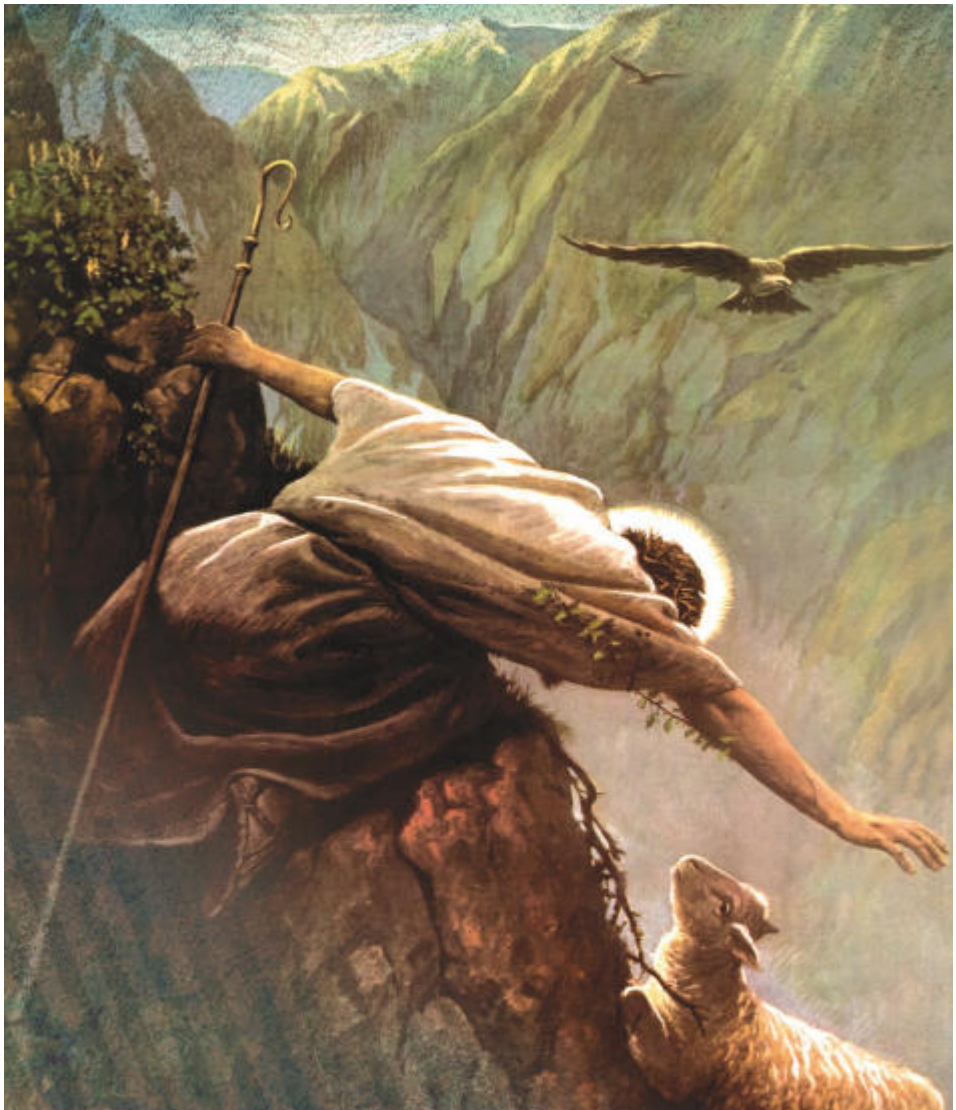

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. KRIS

### FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

This past week, during a morning run, I was trying to come up with an idea of what to write this week. After all the busy-ness of Lent and the first weeks of Easter, my brain seemed to be empty. I had nothing. As two of us were jogging along, we chatted a little, and I was looking for some ideas. Since it was during a run, I was thinking of writing about the importance of taking care of our bodies, and not merely focusing on the soul. After all, God gave us our bodies, and as a gift, we have a responsibility to take care of them.

After we finished our four miles, our conversation took a more profound turn. We found ourselves discussing the challenges of *listening to God*. I've always been one to think that it would be nice if God would just send an email or text message with a to-do list for the day, something that was easy and obvious. Once I got home, and offered my holy hour and had a few cups of coffee, I got to thinking: Listening to God and trying to hear His voice can be difficult! As it stands, though, God works in more mysterious ways, and He's always working in ways that help us to grow in His love. He's always calling, and we're trying to hear what He's saying.

Often times, it all starts in our younger years as we're trying to discern our vocation, God's call for our lives. We wonder: Is God calling me to a religious vocation or to marriage? Maybe He's asking me to live a holy single life? While we know that He has a plan, we want to figure out what that plan is. As we grow, pray, and reflect, we see that He has given signs that often confirm a deep interior sense of His will. It takes time, and sometimes God doesn't make His call explicit until we're ready to hear what He's asking. All along the way, though, He was strengthening us so that we can complete the mission that He has in store.

Our own will complicates things, and it takes time to set our egos aside and let God be Himself. We want to do things our way, on our timeline; we want answers here and now. I think back on last week's Gospel reading when Peter said: "I'm going fishing," then went out in the boat and got skunked. We sometimes have to fight with ourselves, and learn how to live God's way. The good news, in all this, is that none of us are powerful enough to wreck God's plan. Even if we miss His call for our lives, He can work with that and use us where we are, and strengthen us to faithfully follow Him where we end up. We humans grow throughout our lives. Often times, as we grow older, we become more interested in following God's call—and He can work with that.

As we grow in faith, we often find that simply finding God's general call for our lives isn't enough. We find ourselves with a desire to follow Him with each and every day and live for Him with every minute of our lives. We want to enter more deeply into His love. When it comes to living for Him in day-to-day life, though, listening to God isn't as complicated as we make it. We have the teachings of the Church and the Scriptures to guide us. The lives and the writings of the saints give us an example, and their intercession sustains us.

We grow in our knowledge of God and are drawn into a deeper friendship with Him, we find ourselves making time for Mass, the Sacraments, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, devotions, and personal prayer. We want to follow Him, and sometimes we forget that the desire to please God is itself pleasing to Him. Living the teachings of the Scriptures and Tradition effectively guides us in being deeply rooted in the Lord. God calls all of us to holiness, and gives us what we need to do it. We follow Him, though challenging, and find great reward, happiness and peace.
