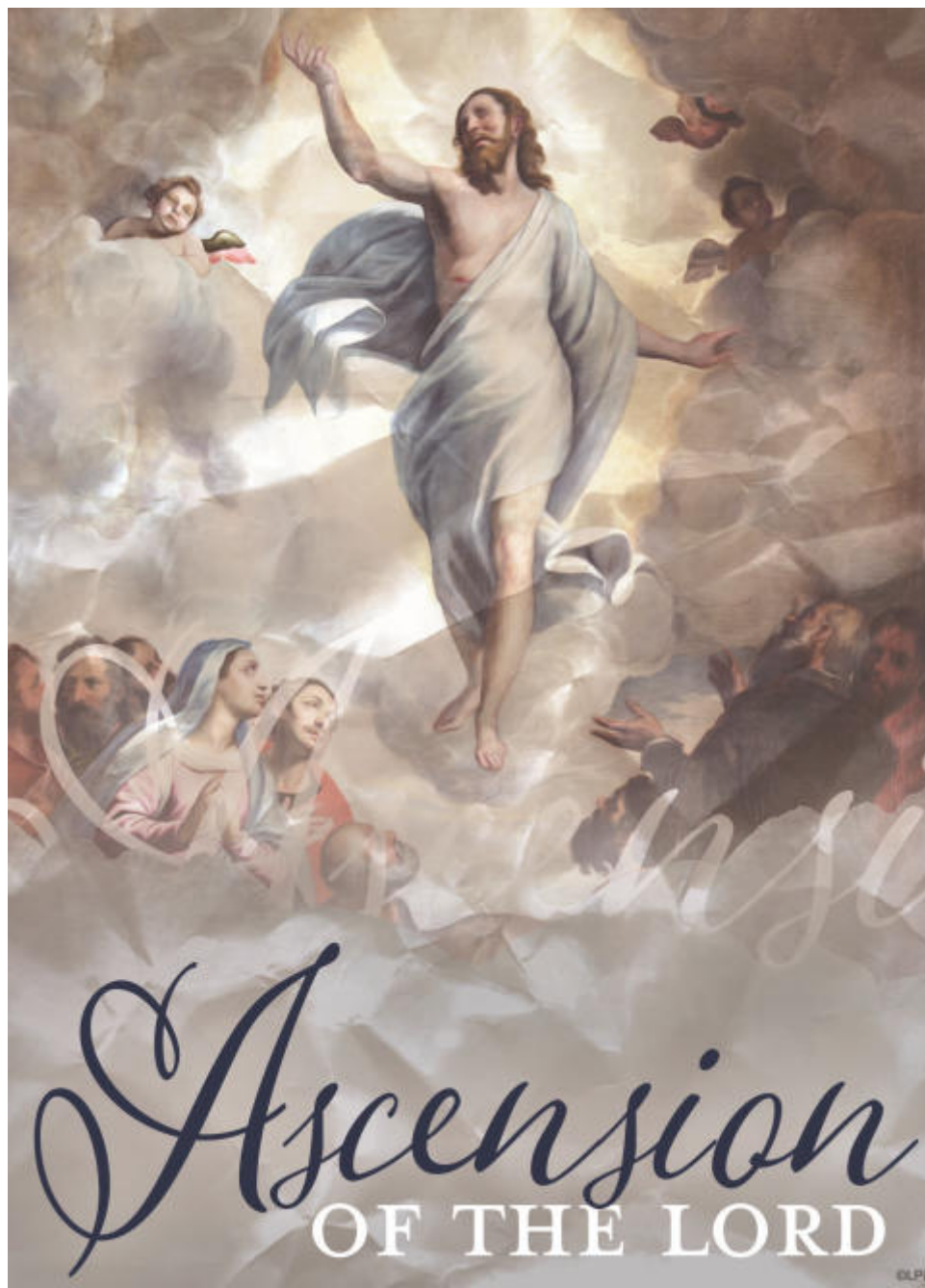

A MESSAGE FROM FR. KRIS SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid. Jesus' words from last Sunday's Gospel have been echoing through my mind all week. We live in a fallen world, and Jesus' promise of peace is something that we often need to hear. We need those reminders that ultimately, it's God who is in control, and that He is trustworthy.

We all go through times in life where we might be overwhelmed or overly busy, and it can be easy to lose our focus on the Lord. As humans, we need those reminders that, with the Lord, there is always hope. No matter what we face, we can always turn to Jesus. Throughout the Scriptures, Jesus often reminds us of His abiding presence, and that we have no reason to fear.

Hope is found in the Lord. We are often times looking for hope and peace somewhere other than in Jesus. We easily get caught up in our own thoughts and our focus shifts to ourselves. One remedy is to be deliberate about looking for God's presence in the moment, seeking His face through prayer. The time we spend in prayer benefits us throughout the day, as it focuses our day on the Lord who cares infinitely for each and all of His people.

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI once commented that *the fact that you exist is proof that God loves you and is thinking about you right now.* God is deeply personal and shouldn't be relegated to the world of ideas or something abstract. God is involved in our lives, even when He seems absent. God so desperately wanted to save His people that the Son entered into the world to rescue us from sin and death. He came to offer eternal life and to give us hope in times of distress.

He also came to challenge us and to call us into a deeper relationship with Himself. Today, as we celebrate Jesus' Ascension back to the Father in Heaven, we are reminded that we are to follow the Risen Lord. He threw open the gates to Heaven for us, and invites us to follow Him. Looking back, we remember the 40 days of Lent, which seem to be in the distant past. We look to the love that the Lord has for His people, and to His desire that we all join Him one day in Heaven.

We know that we are called to follow the Lord with our whole selves. Jesus wants us to give back to Him what He first gave to us because He knows that it leads to happiness, joy and peace. Jesus gives hope to a fallen world. Not only to the world in general, though, but to each of us does He give the peace that the world cannot give. Our challenge is to follow Him and find the joy that awaits those who love Him and follow His words.
