Art of the Wish

Artists Marn Jensen and Andy Newcom interviewed over 200 older people across the country and asked them their wishes — for themselves, their families, and the world. Then, the artists created artwork based on these wishes in hopes to bring them to life in a poignant and memorable way.

The work is comprised of a range of mediums — from photographic to sculptural, textile to encaustic, mixed media to painting — allowing the "wish" to inspire the direction of each piece. The artists were very intentional about the materials used, often incorporating repurposed, found objects that had once been discarded and tossed aside. "Breathing new life into these objects is a perfect metaphor for appreciating the potential and beauty in old things," they explained.

Marn and Andy's wish is that this body of work inspires people to reach out and have a conversation with an elder. They promise, "it will not only make their day, but it will make your day, too."



CAREGIVER SUPPORT

Are you a primary caregiver in Clay County Missouri? Are you caring for someone who is 60 years of age or older? Do you live in the home with the recipient? If so, would you like to be reimbursed for a respite care worker? Caregiver Directed Respite Program provides reimbursement funds to families to assist in obtaining respite care for a family member. Income of care recipient cannot exceed \$3014 a month for individuals or \$4058 a month for a couple.


