

4TH SUNDAY OF ADVENT

In the gospel today, we hear of Mary's actions after the announcement of Jesus' birth by the angel Gabriel. She goes to visit Elizabeth, her cousin, who is also with child. Elizabeth greets her with full recognition of the roles that they and their unborn children will play in God's plan for salvation.

How could we live this season of Advent without considering Mary's role in God's plan of salvation? Elizabeth describes Mary as the first disciple, as the one who believed that God's word to her would be fulfilled. Her deep faith and her openness to God allowed God to work through her so that salvation might come to everyone. May we be like Mary, open to God's plan for salvation.

Today you might want to bring any situation that confuses or frightens you to Mary and Elizabeth. Pray to be graced with great trust in God. God is with you! God will strengthen you and guide you! And eventually, you will be filled with joy!




