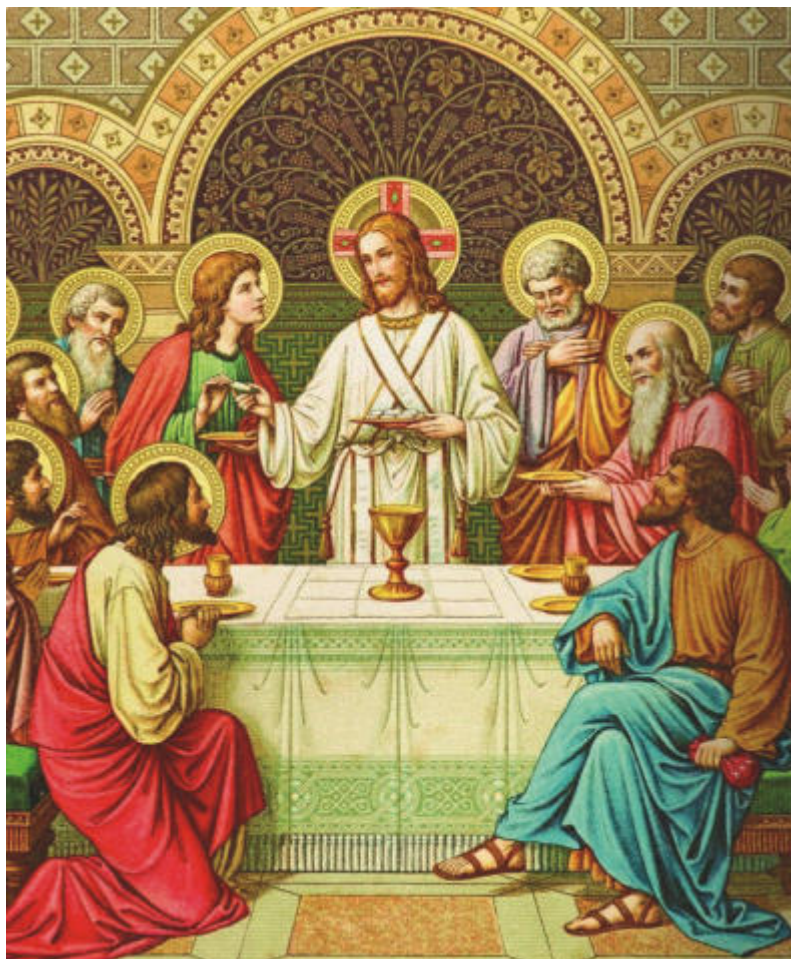

Questions of the Week - Reflect & Respond to Scripture

First Reading: Moses and the ancient Israelites ratified the covenant God established with them at Mount Sinai with the blood of a sacrificed animal. The sacrificed animal affirmed Israel's commitment: "We will do everything the Lord has told us." Why do you think Israel tied sacrificed blood to their verbal commitment?

Second Reading: The author of Hebrews teaches us that the sacrificed blood of Christ sanctifies us and offers us eternal redemption. How do you see this connected to ancient Israel's practice of sacrificing animals for their blood?

Gospel: Mark's account of the institution of the Eucharist is linked to the Jewish Feast of Unleavened Bread when a Pass-over lamb was sacrificed. What do you think Mark is teaching us in making this connection? ©LPi

Hello!!!

Take and eat. Take and drink. Know that I am with you always till the end of time. Wash some feet. Love one another. Give. Pick up your cross and walk. I bet you never knew what you are saying amen to each time you say Amen. This is why we believe Christ is truly present in the Eucharist. Christ is alive calling us to live as he did. We are called to become what we receive. It's hard to fully realize the radical way of living we are called to each time we say Amen.

Many years ago Fr. Ed Cortney called for a vision process that would deal with the future of our Parish. A large part of this process called for a plan that would address the facility needs of our Parish. At the time the plan noted that the School and Assumption Arena were aging and were not efficient in many ways. The plan was general in nature but specific that the facility issues would need to be addressed. The plan called for action in the 2020's.

When I arrived in Chadron I became aware of this past work. In the coming weeks we will be sending you some plans and drawings that lay out some dreams and vision for the future.

Our Parishioner Jerry Moss has shared his talent for design and drawing. We put forth some options and we ask for your comments and feedback. We are still putting the final touches on the presentation, so stay tuned. St. Patrick's Parish is a place with a rich past and a promising future.

Next weekend I will be gone. I will be traveling with another adult and some of our Youth to the One Bread One Cup Program at St. Meinrad Archabbey in Southern Indiana. We will join other Youth and rub some shoulders with some real Benedictine Monks while we learn and experience Catholic Liturgy and rituals. It won't be all work. We plan on playing some during the week and we will make a stop at the St. Louis Arch and our Cathedral in Grand Island.

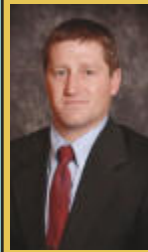
