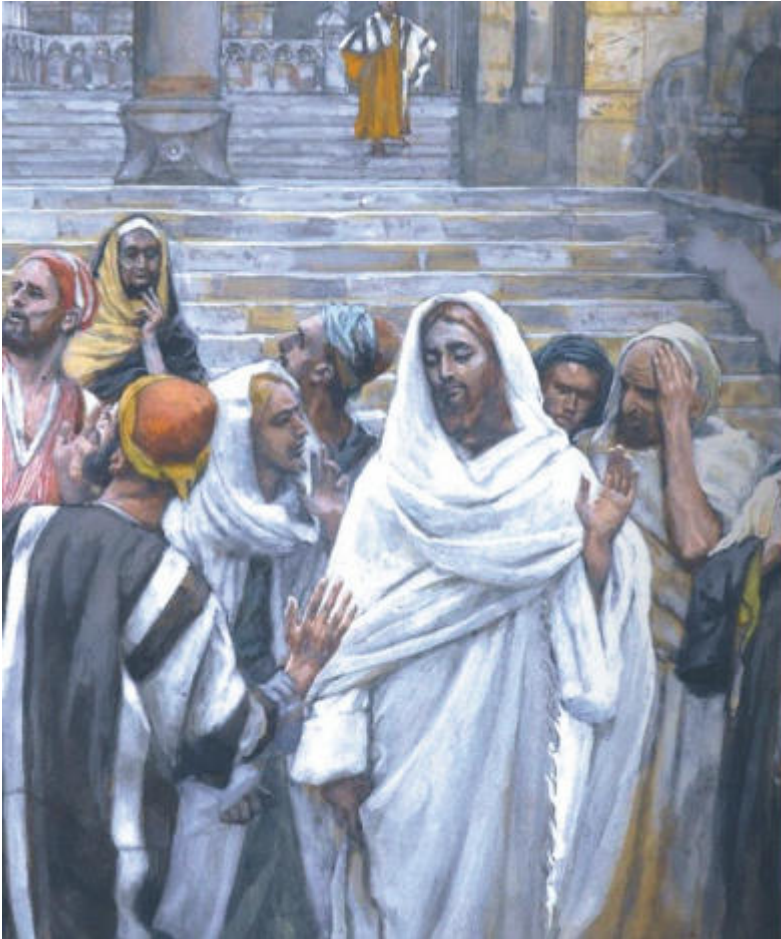

Hello!!

As I write this I can see a huge cloud of smoke on the horizon. I got a call asking that our Parish host 6 firefighters from Imperial, NE. God bless those who help others. God bless those affected by disasters.

As you know we have been planning and dreaming for the future of our buildings on our Parish Campus. One component of the plans for a new Parish Center and a renovated Assumption Arena calls for showers. The firefighters will shower at my house tonight. Our future plans would allow us to more effectively host evacuees, youth groups, etc. We continue to plan, discern and dream.

One of the publications that I regularly read is America Magazine. This is a publication that deals with current news and issues in the Catholic Church. America magazine had two different articles that called for Parish Priests to let people know if they had been vaccinated for covid. One article talked about the Bishop of Lexington, KY who asked his Priests to communicate if they were not vaccinated. Another article was written by a layperson saying he wanted to know his Priest's vaccination status in the interest of safety. I thought this was a good question. I received both vaccines last April. I couldn't get my vaccine soon enough. I rushed to the pharmacy as soon as I got a call from the Health Department. I felt a real sense of relief when I got my shot.
