He goes on to offer some sound advice both spiritual and practical. Among other things he encourages spouses to smile saying:

Happy New Year from the Early Education Center.

This semester marks the mid year of our Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program, infants to pre-k. A special thanks and appreciation to the EEC St. Therese families and the families of the Parish who team to meet the spiritual training of our littlest ones at St. Therese.

On the 3rd floor of the Early Education Center, children who are enrolled in the program escape to "holy ground" and spend time with the word of God in an environment prepared just for them. Here they find time to explore and wonder and tend their relationship with the Christ child and his Mother and the Prophets who fore-

told what would come to pass. They learn about Him, yes, but, they also gradually develop relationships with Him, listening, wondering, praying, serving and exploring.

By January, routines are down and Catechesis begins some of our more detailed and thoughtful work. In Catechesis, children explore the land of Israel, Prophecies, and Infancy narratives and are ready to listen to Jesus' Parables beginning with the parable of the mustard seed. The children (now more adept at pouring) move from watering plants to preparing cruets. Next in Catechesis, the children will explore the gestures of the Mass and wonder about that single drop of water that Father adds to the full chalice of wine. So much learning!

None of this would be possible without the support of our St. Therese parish, Director of Religious Education, Jennifer Davis, and caring parishioners who volunteer to train to be catechists and families who have made the materials used in our classes.



Slowly, families are building connections to one another around this very special program. And to, "Give honor to whom honor is do" I want to gratefully acknowledge the individuals who operate the Catechesis ministry from Jennifer Davis, Nancy Janasz, Carole Joy, and the many volunteers who support the little ones as they learn more about Jesus.

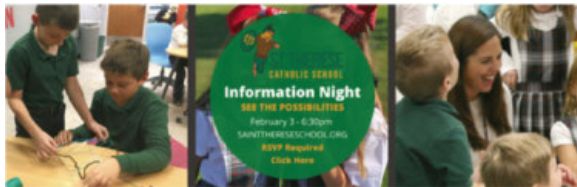
