FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

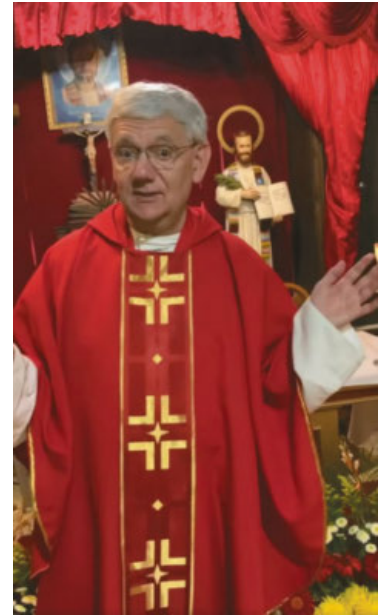
Greetings from Guatemala. Our mission trip from February 4-13 was a blessed and successful experience. See below some photos from our visit.

It's hard to believe, but 2025 is in full swing. The 2024 year end is wrapped up, and we are moving into the new calendar year. Annual contribution statements for 2024 were mailed, and emailed to those who requested it, the last week of January. If you did not receive your contribution statement, or if you found errors in your giving record, please contact the Parish Office. We will be happy to assist you.



The collection of donations for the See the Possibilities Campaign is in its final stages. Over 95% of pledges have been collected, and work continues on the rectory. As the rectory progresses through the spring with an estimated completion in early summer, we will be preparing for more summer projects. If you have not completed your pledge to the campaign and need information on your balance, again contact the Parish Office.

The budgeting process for 2025-2026 has already begun. New labor laws, a significant increase to Missouri minimum wage, increased personnel expenses, and a number of maintenance projects are making this year particularly challenging. The success of the See the Possibilities Campaign eliminated our debt, relieving the parish of over \$300k in principal and interest payments each year. Coupling these savings with continued regular giving of our parishioners, the financial lifeline of the parish, enables us to continue our great work. Because of your generosity, the church is able to meet these needs and help our community thrive. Thank you for continuing to support the mission of St. Therese.
