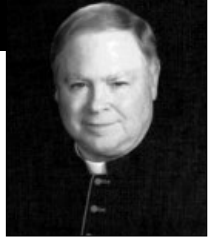

**MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

**DO WHATEVER HE TELLS YOU**

The instruction that Mary gives to the “servers” in today’s Gospel should be heeded by any Christian desiring to do God’s will. It represents the answer that any young person who is discerning a vocation to the priesthood, consecrated life or marriage will receive from praying to Mary. As we observe the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, it represents the attitude which the participants in ecumenical dialogues should bring to the table. With the March for Life in Washington, DC, this week, it represents the conviction of all who have the courage to speak for and defend the God-given right to life and the dignity of every human being. To paraphrase today’s First Reading: “For the sake of the unborn I will not be silent; for the sake of the right to life I will not be quiet.”

Today’s Second Reading reminds us that God has enriched his Church with a variety of gifts, charisms, vocations and ministries. All should be used to build up the unity of the Body of Christ and to carry out the Church’s mission. Each of us has a part to play in that. For some it is to speak out; for others it is to do penance and to pray. No good gift that comes from God fails to bear fruit. Let us offer our gifts to the Lord.

The annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity begins this Tuesday, January 18, and ends the next Tuesday, January 25, the Feast of the Conversion of Saint Paul. This year’s theme is: “We Saw the Star in the East, and We Came To Worship Him.” This is the explanation of the theme: “Like the Magi who braved the perils of a long and dangerous journey to find the Christ child, our Christian brothers and sisters in the Middle East face many hardships as they strive to live out their faith in Christ. Our prayer in solidarity with their suffering is a light of hope and communion.”

The Catholic Bishops of the United States have decreed that January 22, the anniversary of *Roe v. Wade*, is to be observed annually as a day of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion, and of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life. Texts appropriate for this observance will be used in a special 8:30 AM Mass on Saturday at St. Charles.

Unfortunately due to COVID concerns the diocesan trip to the annual March for Life in Washington, DC, has been cancelled. Even so, tune in to EWTN for live coverage of a number of these events, especially Thursday-evening’s Mass at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception (4:30 PM) and live coverage of the march on Friday (beginning at 8:30 AM).

There have been so many devastating acts of nature this fall and I believe many of us would like to help. Nearby there was the tornado in Stanley. Just before that there were the tornadoes devastating a 200-mile area from Arkansas to Kentucky. More recently there was the Marshall Fire that destroyed 1,000 homes in Boulder County, Colorado. Our own Catholic Charities of the Diocese of La Crosse has a fund for those affected by the tornado in Stanley. Catholic Charities USA has a disaster-relief fund for the Arkansas-Kentucky tornadoes and the Marshall Fire in Colorado. Next weekend we will take up a second collection for these funds. Whatever is collected will be divided 30% to Stanley and 70% to Catholic Charities USA. Any checks should be made payable to your parish.

Pray the Rosary this week for an end to legalized abortion and the many other crimes against human life and dignity, for the unity of Christians, for people affected by natural disasters and, as always, pray for peace.

May God bless his people with peace.

Dear sponsors of St. Charles Borromeo Parish,

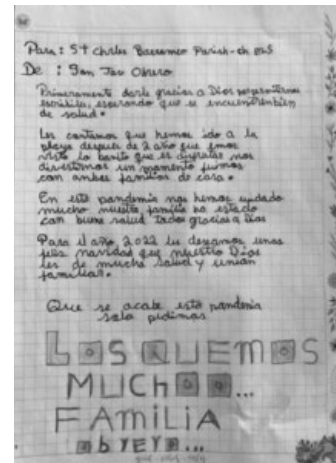
First of all, we want to thank God for allowing us to write to you, and we are hoping that you are in good health.

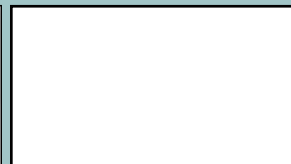
