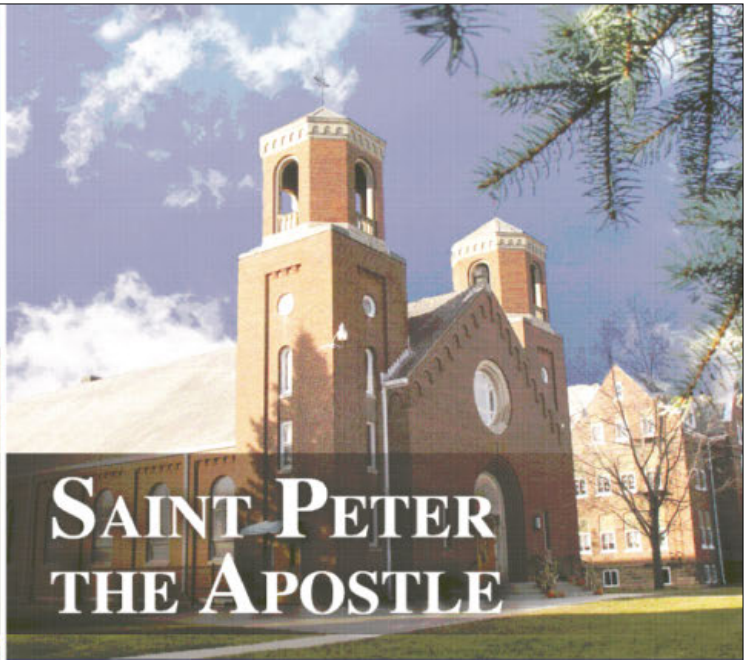
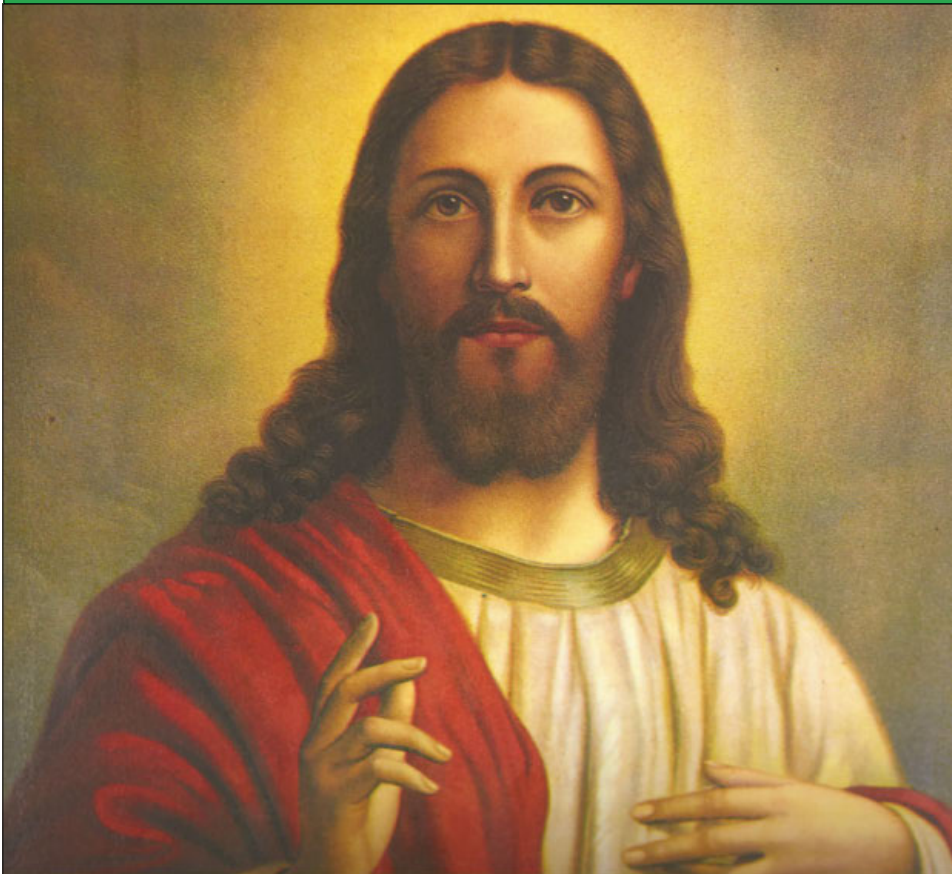

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

This weekend's Gospel (Luke 13:22-30) presents a challenging question posed to Jesus: "Lord, will only a few be saved?" The question carries a hint of sarcasm, as many found Jesus' teachings too strict and demanding.

Today, some Christians echo this skepticism, softening Jesus' message to make salvation seem easier and more assured. Certain interpretations of Christianity have diluted His teachings to the point of being unrecognizable. While the Catholic Church officially upholds the rigor of Jesus' call, some individuals, even clergy, have at times drifted toward these misguided approaches.

Jesus responds by urging us to "strive to enter through the narrow gate." This image evokes a marathon, where only those who have trained diligently can pass through the finish line. In other words, salvation requires a dedicated journey filled with challenges and perseverance. Jesus emphasizes that many will try to enter, but only those with sufficient strength will succeed. This strength is not physical but moral—a spiritual resilience built through faith.

We can live this life in many ways, some good, others less so. Yet only one path truly leads to heaven: the narrow way of Jesus. He reinforces this with another vivid image, describing those who knock on the door, saying, "Lord, open the door for us!" But God responds, "Depart from me, all you evildoers!" Merely knocking is not enough; we must have the strength to enter.

Jesus builds this strength in us gradually, day by day. Through prayer, the sacraments, and growing in our faith, we are formed to live out our salvation. God also provides opportunities to practice charity, shaping us to reflect His love. Through our vocations—whether marriage, priesthood, or another calling—we learn to love and be loved, opening our hearts to God's grace.

It would be simpler to believe everyone automatically goes to heaven or that being kind just once is enough to enter. However, this has never been the teaching of the Catholic Church. Our faith is both challenging and profound, requiring a lifetime of commitment. Yet it is also a gift, offered by Jesus to those open to receiving it. Let us pray that we remain focused on the narrow Catholic path, undistracted by broader, easier ways.

The Diocese of Tiruchi is located in the Southern part of India and is blessed with 118 priests serving in 73 parishes with 282 mission stations. It is multi religious in nature, clustered with major religions such as Hinds, Muslims, Buddhists & Jains. The main source of income is agriculture and daily labor. Due to this, education was not valued in the past. Most of the learners now are the first-generation.
