



Once again, we need your help. Over the next three weekends we will have a box in the gathering space to collect the following items:







Any suspected or known abuse of a minor must be immediately reported to the Missouri Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline at 800-392-3738, and suspected or known abuse of adults to the Missouri Adult Abuse and Neglect Hotline 800-392-0210. Suspected or known abuse may also be reported to law enforcement agencies.

Failure to Report is a Class A Misdemeanor for a person who is required under the law to report. No supervisor may interfere with or impede the reporting of suspected abuse. Filing a False Report is also a Class A Misdemeanor.


