

The parable in today's Gospel clearly warns that we, like the fig tree, will be judged by our fruit. While God mercifully provides us with time and opportunity, let us give witness to our faith with deeds of kindness and generosity!

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HERTGES

We are VERY BLESSED to have Archbishop Jackels present this Sunday afternoon to confer the sacrament of Confirmation upon our high-school aged candidates for this third sacrament of initiation. Archbishop Jackels has not been present at St. Benedict Parish for Confirmation, or any other liturgy for that matter, since April 7, 2019! Prior to that, he was here for the dedication Mass of the new altar and was responsible for blessing the completion of our renovation project back in October 2018.

I don't know about all of you, but for me, these aforementioned occasions seem and feel like a lifetime ago. Interestingly enough, some of you may recall that the Archbishop was scheduled to confer Confirmation on March 22, 2020, but that of course had to be cancelled, amongst many other things as the pandemic protocols really starting to first be manifested. Thank-God that is all behind us; and for as grateful as I was to be able to tend to confirming our young people these last two years, this sacrament is generally the bishop or archbishop's pastoral prerogative. Generally speaking, Confirmation is usually the one, and often the only, time that the Archbishop is at a parish to visit members of his flock and be the principal celebrant of the Mass in any given year, with few exceptions.

Having stated all of that, many blessings, prayers, and good wishes to our young people who are having the gifts of the Holy Spirit sealed within them this Sunday. May they all continue to accept and grow in the Holy Spirit's strengthening and guidance all throughout their lives, especially in the times in which we currently live!

While I am on the topics of strengthening and sacraments, I wish to remind everyone concerned that *next weekend- March 26th and 27th will be our communal offering of the anointing of the sick.* This sacrament is intended for those of advanced years, those anticipating or recovering from surgery or other medical procedures, and also includes those who deal with chronic/severe illnesses such as Parkinson's Disease, cancer, diabetes, heart disease, in addition to anxiety and depression. This is definitely not an exhaustive list of health problems that people have or possibly will have throughout the course of their earthly lives.

Even with all the fixation upon the Coronavirus these past two years, these other health maladies I have mentioned did not magically disappear in the wake of the pandemic, but often will or have the potential to claim people's lives. Please note too that there will not be a drive-up option for anointing this time as even in the fall of 2021 not many parishioners utilized this option and the "normal" means of receiving this sacrament is within the context of the liturgy of the anointing; either at church, people's homes and/or hospital or nursing home facilities.

Finally, I wish to conclude this week's "spiel" with yet another reminder that *this weekend* Deacon Nick and I will be conducting training and commissioning for new extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion in addition to a refresher training for those who used to distribute the Eucharist prior to March of 2020.

This will take place immediately after all three Masses and should not last longer than a half an hour. Those who wish to distribute Holy Communion at Mass or take the Body of Christ to the homebound must be baptized Roman Catholics and in good standing with the Church. Hopefully and God-willing, we will once again have extraordinary ministers assisting with the distribution of Holy Communion by next weekend.


